1.	Whether a self-certified undertaking from beneficiaries to the effect that they do not own any pucca house anywhere in the country may be taken.	State/UTs will have the flexibility to accept a self-certified undertaking from the beneficiaries, certifying that they do not own any pucca house anywhere in India. States/UTs will, however, observe due diligence through cross checking with the beneficiary information made available from other sources as prescribed in Para 7.2 and Para 8.4 of the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) Mission Guidelines.
