Current Status of Compliance

IHSDP - Progress from Jan'16

As on 31/12/2015 the Non started DUs were 14,341 Nos and now this figure is reduced to 2,511 Nos meaning thereby during the said tenure we started 7,152 DUs excluding 4,678 DUs surrendered. Now only 2,511 DUs has to be started which we are putting efforts to start upto Aug'17.

As on 31/12/2015 the number of DUs completed was 4,669 Nos and now this figure is increased to 12,670 Nos meaning thereby during the said tenure we completed 8,001 DUs.

RAY - Progress from Jan'16

As on 31/12/2015 the Non started DUs were 9,386 Nos and now this figure is reduced to 6,711 Nos meaning thereby during the said tenure we started 2,675 DUs. Now only 6,711 DUs has to be started which we are putting efforts to start upto Aug'17.

As on 31/12/2015 the number of DUs completed was 25 Nos and now this figure is increased to 1,158 Nos meaning thereby during the said tenure we completed 1,133 DUs

Action taken to expedite the progress of IHSDP & RAY Scheme

At ULB level, to ensure and expedite the completion of IHSDP the services of NGOs and Samuhik Vikas Samiti (SVS) has been taken by each ULBs for awareness.

The provision of Project Management Unit (PMU) has been made by state government to fill up the gap of skilled man power to support the ULBs to implement the IHSDP & RAY schemes.

Fortnightly camps are being organised by ULBs to release the instalment, these camps are also used for social audit and awareness the beneficiaries.

Although the JnNRUM was sanctioned in 2005, in Bihar physical work of IHSDP was started by HPL in 2008 and by <u>respective ULBs in 2014 only</u>



Observation No.6 during 7th CSMC

Current Status of Compliance

Training for surveyors was organised for all approved 85 ULBs and for remaining ULBs training programme is scheduled in 27/07/2016.

Observation No.2 during 7th CSMC

Plan to ensure beneficiary contribution

Current Status of Compliance

All the projects submitted so far are under the Beneficiary Led Construction component of PMAY (U) and hence the following components of the estimated cost shall need not to be borne by the Beneficiary:

- The overhead charges and contractor's profit, which amounts to 15%, shall not be applicable and will be deducted from the estimate because the construction will be carried out by beneficiaries themself.
- Total labour cost works out to 22% of the estimate, of which 7% is for skilled labor and 15% is for unskilled labour. The beneficiary will contribute in terms of unskilled labour. So, 15% of the total estimated cost in terms of finance shall not be borne by beneficiary.
- For the entire state, only two sources for sand and aggregates were considered in the SoR, whereas during construction local materials are being used by beneficiaries and hence the carriageway cost is considered as 5% of estimate instead of 20%.
- Under Mukya mantri Saat Nischa Yojana, each house in Bihar will be provided with water supply and electricity connection free of cost and hence the cost earmarked for PHE & electrical works shall be reduced and the same is to be considered under state contribution. Initially, the state contribution was Rs. 50,000 which will now be from Rs. 1,14,508 to Rs. 1,18,295 (lowest cost estimate to highest cost estimate)

The above para wise explanation will make it clear that financial contribution by the Beneficiary will range from **Rs.8,701 to Rs. 20,956** (for the lowest cost to highest cost estimate), which is evidently reasonable.
