Strategy / Goal of CSP

The main objective of the City Sanitation Plan is that these cities Achieve Totally Safe Environmental Sanitation that lead to Healthy and Livable Cities Ensure sustainable good public health standards and environmental upgradation for all cities with a special focus on Hygienic and Affordable Sanitation Facilities for the Urban Poor, women and all vulnerable groups.



- Funds by GoI for ILCS / JNNURM / UIDSSMT and by GoM for Sujal Nirmal Maharashtra Abhiyan and Nagarotthan will be taken into consideration while preparing the Infrastructure / Investment Plan for City Sanitation Plan.
- Participation of NGOs, Media, Citizens is being solicited through Task Force / Implementing Agency / Ward Committees / Mohalla Committees / Brand Ambassadors / Citywise Competitions / Teachers and Students
- The Funds provided to Develop CSP is being utilized for Capacity Building of various Stakeholders in Preparation of CSP



- Short Term & Long Term Goals and Sustainability Plan..... Cost Recovery?

Challenges / Capacity Enhanced Needs of ULB

- Even though ULB has capacity to develop CSP sectorwise, for developing CSP in an integrated manner, capacity building is necessary.
- CSP will be developed In-house
- Training is required for developing CSP in an Integrated manner including Technical Options / Behavioral Changes / Awareness Generation / IEC / Media Handling.



- Best Practices in Urban Sanitation that can be replicated
 - Low Cost Waste Water Treatment / Reuse and Disposal System Developed by Ashta Municipal Council
 - Dewats System Introduced by Kolhapur Municipal Corporation
 - Plastic to Fuel Plant by PCMC
 - Use of Bio-Sanitizer in the Waste Water Treatment
 System by Nasik Municipal Corporation



- Specific Challenges Considering the Implementation of CSP the suggestions made during workshops and meetings are -
 - Modifications in the State Act to provide Sanitation Facilities to Slum Dwellers irrespective of Tenure.
 - Delegation of Powers to State and further to ULBs under Indian Penal Code / Criminal Procedure Code / Civil Procedure Code for imposing the fine and recovering the same from the offender.
- Additional Support required from MoUD and others
 - Experience Sharing for cross learning
 - Study Visits
 - **Model City Development**
 - **Communication Strategy**
