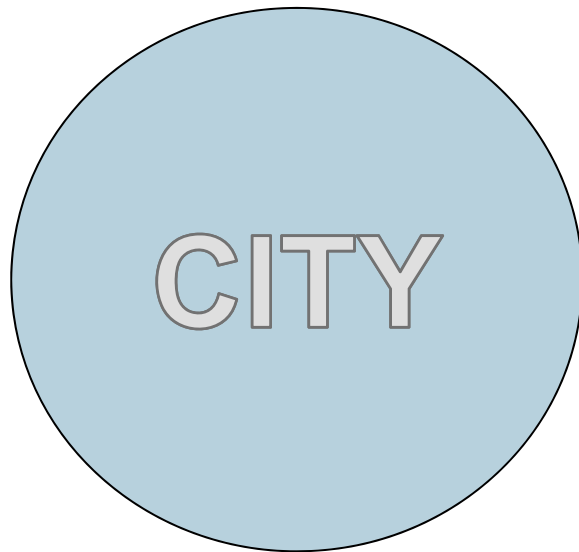


Map 4.1 Type of Toilets



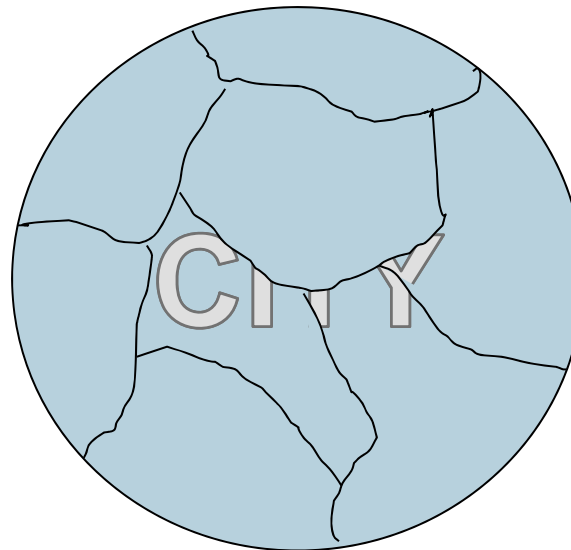

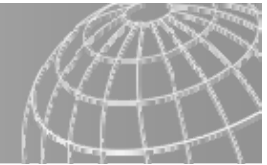


CSP implementation (suboptimal)
