Earlier, the fund of Rs. 1,50,39,000/- (Rs. 34.12315 lakh for SLTC and Rs. 118.26 lakh for 13 CLTCs) was released to Govt. of Himachal Pradesh as 1st instalment of Central Assistance for establishment of SLTC and 13 CLTCs for the year 2017-18 after adjustment of excess funds of 1.71 lakh released for CLTCs for the year 2017-18 fund vide sanction letter of even number dated 28.06.2017. The State Govt. of Himachal Pradesh has submitted the Utilization Certificate of Rs. 1,90,21,640/- against the said release.

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- 3. The above grant is subject to the following conditions:
 - (i) The State will comply with the terms and conditions stipulated in the guidelines, CSMC directions and instructions issued by this Ministry.
 - (ii) The State will utilize the sanctioned grant for the purpose for which it is released. The State Government/Nodal Agency shall furnish physical and financial progress reports every quarter.
 - (iii) The State will furnish the Expenditure Statement/Utilization Certificate as per GFR 2017 along with the details of Specialists engaged subject to financial norms approved by 1st CSMC as well as adherence to scheme guidelines.
 - (iv) Further installment of funds will be considered on receipt of expenditure statement/UC from the State Government along with details of specialists engaged subject to financial norms approved by 1st CSMC as well as adherence to scheme guidelines, furnishing clarifications/supporting documents and submission of pending UCs under RAY, if any.
 - (v) The State Government/Nodal Agency shall strictly monitor the progress of the preparatory work.
 - (vi) The amount of Central Assistance approved will form a part of capacity building plan of the State under PMAY-HFA (Urban) mission.
 - (vii) Where there is an element of cash transfer, the same may be made through PFMS/DBT mode as applicable.
