

Implementation Strategy

Based on the CSP recommendation identify:

- Immediate
- Medium term and
- Long term plans
- Initiate detailed planning and Capacity

Building training

- Preparation of DPRs
- Financial provisions
- Implement activities
- Training and CB



Hoshangabad: following steps already initiated

- DPR for 2625 individual toilets has been prepared and approved under ILCS
 - Construction of individual toilets initiated
- Construction of community toilets and public toilets initiated- finance through IUSP and NRCP
- DPR for implementing SWM interventions being prepared
 - Meanwhile Door to door collection initiated in two wards

Hoshangabad: following steps already initiated

- Main sewer trunk and STP being supported under NRCP is under revision at the state and central Govt. (MoEF) level
- Training and capacity building programme, including exposure visit to the best practices done
- IEC and awareness generation activities initiated

Following components are to be implemented:

- Waste water conveyance system
- Septage management system
- Construction of soak pits for existing WCs with septic tanks
- Integrated SWM system
- Demonstration of decentralized options for waste water management
- Training and capacity building for the ULB
- City wide IEC and awareness campaign

Interventions in other cities

- 4 CSP ready, 3 more in two months
- 37 CSP 4 months (May/June-2011)
- 36 CSP 6 months (July/Aug- 2011)
