#### URBAN SANITATION SITUATION IN INDIA





- 26 percent do not have any household sanitation arrangements.
- As high as 82 percent of urban households may be disposing off human wastes in an unsafe manner.
- 80 percent of surface water pollution is due to municipal sewage alone.
- 70 percent wastewater from the sewerage systems not treated.

# DISTRIBUTION OF CITIES AMONG RATING CLASSES



S.No.	Category	Range	No. of Cities
1	Red	< 33 Marks	189
2	Black	<34 - 66 Marks	230
3	Blue	<67 – 90 Marks	4
4	Green	<91 – 100 Marks	0

It can be concluded from the rating results:

- 189 cities are on the brink of public health and environmental 'emergency'; needing immediate remedial action.
- ■230 cities need considerable improvements.
- Only 4 cities are recovering but still diseased.
- •Out of 423 cities, no city is the in the category of healthy and clean city.





### **CHANGED PERSPECTIVE: Outcome Focused**

The emphasis will not be on the physical infrastructure per se but on:

- Behaviour change outcomes
- Proper usage
- Institutional reorientation
- Regular upkeep and maintenance
- Increased Accountability: Service delivery by ULBs/their delegated agents.



#### PROGRESS SO FAR



- Strong/continued commitment from Government of India
- •Out of 24 states committed for developing state sanitation strategies, 5 states have submitted their first draft and 5 are in stage of submission.
- 92 cities have assured submission of their City Sanitation Plans to MoUD by 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2011. (Including support from MoUD and six Multi-lateral agencies)
- 85 cities, with fiscal support from MoUD, 53 cities have reported formation of City Sanitation Task Force (CSTF).
- The baseline data collection and creation of Database/GIS is still in progress in 71 cities and only 14 cities have reported completion.


•Rating of 423 cities was presented in May 2010 with brainstorming exercise done in few states as follow up exercise.



## STATUS OF CITY SANITATION TASK FORCE




(Progress of MoUD supported cities)





# STATUS OF BASELINE DATA COLLECTION AND CREATION OF DATABASE/ GIS











# STATUS OF STATE SANITATION STRATEGY (SSS) (as agreed in November 2009 meeting)
