

Key Amendments under PMAY(U) Guidelines:

- The Coverage of the PMAY(U) mission has been extended from 4041 statutory towns to all areas falling within notified Planning/ Development area under the jurisdiction of an Industrial Development Authority/ Special Area Development Authority Urban Development Authority or any such Authority under State legislation.
- The definition of Beneficiary has been amended to include an adult earning member (irrespective of marital status) to be treated as a separate household.
- Under the CLSS scheme, Interest subsidy for loan has been extended by five years, i.e. a tenure of 20 years which was earlier 15 years only.
- Addition of other financial institutions (as approved by Reserve Bank of India) in the definition of PLIs like Small Financial Banks, Non-Banking Financial Company Micro Finance Institutions' (NBFC–MFIs).
- Under CLSS for MIG the existing carpet area of MIG I and II has been increased from 90 sq.m and 110 sq.m to 120 sq.m and 150 sq.m respectively.
- The time period of the CLSS for MIG extended by 15 months beyond the initial approval of one year period i.e. upto 31.03.2019.
