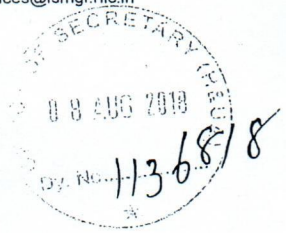

Dear Secretary,

As you are aware, that Accessible India Campaign (AIC) (Sugamya Bharat Abhiyan) is a flagship programme of Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwD) under Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment. A meeting of Committee of Secretaries (CoS) under the Chairmanship of Cabinet Secretary was held on 2nd April 2018 to review the progress made under Accessible India Campaign.

2. During the meeting it emerged that some progress has been made towards achieving the targets under AIC by the concerned Ministries/Departments.

3. Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY) has been entrusted the responsibility to follow up with the concerned Ministries and State Governments to **make all Government websites Accessible and to monitor the progress.**

4. This is to reiterate here that NIC has formulated guidelines for Indian Government websites. The second version of the guidelines has been released by NIC in February 2018. It is available on the **website at guidelines.gov.in**. Resources pertaining to the techniques and best practice for compliance to the guidelines are also provided in the website.

5. You are requested to monitor the progress in this regard and intimate the progress made in this direction on monthly basis. The **monthly status report received will be compiled and sent to Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwD) for updation in e-Samiksha portal.** The report for the period ending 31st July 2018 may be sent by 10th August 2018 and thereafter by 5th of each month.
