G.S.R. 187- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Ministry of Works and Housing Adviser (Public Health Environmental Engineering) Recruitment Rules, 1984 published in the Gazette of India, Part II Section 3, Sub Section (i) number G.S.R. 763 dated the 14th July, 1984 and Ministry of Urban Development Adviser (Public Health Environmental Engineering) (Amendment) Rules, 1986, except as respects things done or omitted to be done in such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Adviser, (Public Health Environmental Engineering) in the Ministry of urban Development and Poverty Alleviation namely:-

1. Short title and commencement – (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Urban Development and Poverty Alleviation Adviser (Public Health Environmental Engineering) Recruitment Rules, 2001.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay etc. – The number of the said posts, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment to the said post age limit, qualification and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualifications. – No person.-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person, and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.– Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Casts, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
