**MINUTES OF THE 166<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF THE CENTRAL SANCTIONING AND MONITORING COMMITTEE (CSMC) OF THE BASIC SERVICES TO THE URBAN POOR (BSUP) UNDER JAWAHARLAL NEHRU NATIONAL URBAN RENEWAL MISSION (JNNURM)**

**Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi, 6th July, 2015**

The 166<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) of the Sub-Mission on Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) was held under the Chairpersonship of the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation on 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 at 10.30 a.m. in Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I**. Joint Secretary & Mission Director welcomed Secretary, Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation and Chairperson CSMC. Joint Secretary informed that CSMC is examining UCs submitted by States/UTs for issue of next installments in the projects under JNNURM. It was further stated that all the ongoing projects sanctioned upto 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2012 need to be fully completed within the extended period i.e. by 31.03.2017. Following directions were reiterated:

- i. States shall submit Utilization Certificates for ongoing projects for claiming balance ACA or adjustment of excess ACA. Any unadjusted excess ACA needs to be refunded to Government of India with interest at applicable rate.**
- ii. States should not make any adjustment of excess ACA with them on their own without sanction of CSMC. Mission Directorate shall ensure that the installments sanctioned in the CSMC/CSC meetings are either adjusted against excess unutilized ACA lying with the concerned State/UT or released expeditiously.**
- iii. States are requested to send project completion certificates expeditiously for the completed projects.**

2. The Minutes of the 165<sup>th</sup> CSMC meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2015 were confirmed.

3. CSMC considered the following proposals as per agenda and based on presentations made by the State Government officials/representatives.

**4. West Bengal**

**4.1 Proposal for sanction of ACA for BSUP Phase III Project of Kalyani Municipality**

4.1.1 The CSMC in its 158<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 11/11/2014 had considered the 4<sup>th</sup> and final instalment for this project. CSMC, however, had observed that work on 250 DUs had not started and TPIMA had informed that these 250 DUs were not expected to start at all. The CSMC, therefore, approved the final instalment after deducting ACA of Rs. 3.0118 cr. for the non starter 250 DUs and directed that the ACA be released on receipt of present status of the project and after adjustment of components/DUs to be dropped. The proposal again came up in 161<sup>st</sup> CSMC for considering full ACA in the project as no DUs would need to be dropped, as proposed by the State. CSMC, however, had directed HUDCO to inspect the

site and to submit a Site Inspection Report (SIR) from their regional office on the project before the full and final ACA is considered by CSMC. HUDCO carried out Site Inspection on 27.02.2015 and informed the Ministry vide their letter dated 13.03.2015, inter-alia, stating that out of 3488 sanctioned DUs in Kalyani Ph-III project, 1692 DUs have been completed and 1796 DUs are in progress, i.e all the sanctioned DUs including the 250 DUs that were earlier reported as non-starters have been taken up. HUDCO also reported that the infrastructure components as per sanction have been taken up and are in advance stages of progress.

4.1.2 State Government representative informed the Chair that out of 3488 sanctioned DUs, 1805 DUs have been completed and 1683 DUs are in progress. The overall financial progress is 79%. The Committee also noted that 79% of released Central Share has been utilized. Further, the infrastructure components as per sanction have been taken up and are in advance stage of progress.

4.1.3 The Committee noted the progress and approved ACA of Rs. 1050.52 lakh for the BSUP project at Kalyani Phase-III as per Annexure – II superseding the approval in the 158<sup>th</sup> CSMC meeting held on 11.11.2014. The ACA approved shall be adjusted against excess ACA available with the State Govt.

#### 4.2. Proposal for sanction of 4<sup>th</sup> (final) instalment: BSUP scheme for the town of Maheshtala (Phase-II)

4.2.1 The State representative informed that out of 2167 sanctioned DUs, 1871 are completed, all of which are occupied and the remaining 296 DUs are under progress. The State representative further informed the Committee that the State Government has sanctioned Rs. 12.00 cr. for meeting cost escalation in the project and they will thus be able to complete the project along with the approved infrastructure. The Committee noted that 84% of the released central share has been utilized.

4.2.2 The State representative informed the Committee that in place of TPIMA report, a report on site inspection carried out by KMDA, the SLNA has been submitted to HUDCO. The representative from HUDCO expressed satisfaction over the quality of works.

4.2.3. The Committee noted the progress and approved release of Rs. 700.02 lakh as 4<sup>th</sup> and final instalment of ACA for the project, detailed at Annexure - II. The ACA approved shall be adjusted against excess ACA available with the State.

#### 4.3 Proposal for restoration/dropping of DUs in West Bengal

Consequent upon the Review Meeting held in the Ministry on 04.06.2015, the Govt. of West Bengal, vide letter No 88/KMDA/P&M/Genl-313 dated 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2015 has requested for reinstatement of 1551 DUs in 5 projects and further dropping of 47 DUs in 2 projects in West Bengal. The project-wise details are as under:

**4.3.1 The Committee deliberated on the issue and approved the proposal of the State Government for reinstatement of 1551 DUs in 5 BSUP projects and further cancellation of 47 DUs in 2 BSUP projects as detailed above, and ACA thereof.**

## **5. Odisha**

**5.1.1 Proposal for restoration of 1447 dropped DUs in BSUP and IHSDP projects in Odisha.**

5.1.2 The State representative informed the Committee that 160<sup>th</sup> CSMC held on 23.12.2014 had dropped 2229 DUs in Odisha. Out of these 2229 dropped DUs, the State Government has proposed to reinstate 1447 DUs. These DUs have been started on ground. The State representative further informed that out of 15605 sanctioned DUs in the State of Odisha, 10260 DUs are completed and 4563 DUs are under construction. The remaining 782 DUs which could not be started have been proposed to be dropped.

**5.2.2 The Committee approved the above proposal of the State for restoration/dropping of DUs in the projects as detailed at Annexure - III.**

6. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
