# Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi, 17th June 2013

The 140<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Central Sanctioning Committee (CSC) of the Scheme on Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) was held under the Chairpersonship of Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2013 at 4.00 p.m. in NBO MIS Centre, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi. The list of participants is at Annexure–I. The OSD (JNNURM), M/o HUPA reiterated that this being the last extended year for completion of BSUP & IHSDP projects under JNNURM, concerted efforts should be made to complete all the sanctioned projects and implementation of 3 pro-poor reforms under BSUP and IHSDP components of JNNURM before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2014. It was also informed that the ACA allocation for 2013-14 is Rs. 2694.00 crores against the overall committed liability of about Rs. 7000 crores, which is far less. He urged upon all State/UT Governments to claim the balance ACA immediately so that the request for additional allocation over and above BE 2013-14 can be made.

2. The details of the proposals put up and considered by the CSC are given in the succeeding paragraphs.

# A Gujarat

A.1 The proposal for <u>release of 2<sup>nd</sup> & final installment of ACA</u> for IHSDP project of "Revised DPR for provision of infrastructure facilities for Una layout for Junagarh Distt. Gujarat" was discussed in the meeting. The TPIMA report had been analyzed by the HUDCO and overall quality of work—was found to be satisfactory. The State Government representative informed that out of 1008 DUs, 384 DUs have been fully completed and 624 DUs are at different stages of construction. Physical and financial progress is found to be satisfactory. The Committee asked the representative of the State Government to complete the project as per the sanctioned covenant of the DPRs within the extended period. The Committee also noted that the 3 pro-poor reforms certificates have been furnished by the State.

A.2 The Committee approved and recommended the release of 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of ACA for Revised DPR for provision of infrastructure



facilities for Una layout for Junagarh Distt. Gujarat as per the details at Annexure- II.

### B Jammu & Kashmir

- B.1 The proposal for <u>release of 2<sup>nd</sup> & final installment of ACA</u> for IHSDP projects at (i) Ramnagar and (ii) Mattan were discussed in the meeting. The TPIMA reports were analyzed by the HUDCO and the overall quality of work was found to be satisfactory. Physical and financial progress is found to be satisfactory. The Committee asked the representative of the State Government to complete the projects as per the sanctioned covenant of the DPRs within the extended period. The Committee also noted that the 3 pro-poor reforms certificates have been furnished by the State.
- B.2 The Committee approved and recommended the release of 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of ACA (i) Ramnagar and (ii) Mattan as per the details at Annexure-III (A & B).
- B.3 The proposal for <u>release of balance 50% of 2<sup>nd</sup> & final installment of ACA</u> for IHSDP project at Parole town was discussed in the meeting. The TPIMA report was analyzed by the HUDCO and the overall quality of work was found to be satisfactory. Physical and financial progress is found to be satisfactory. The Committee asked the representative of the State Government to complete the project as per the sanctioned covenant of the DPR within the extended period. The Committee also noted that the 3 pro-poor reforms certificates have been furnished by the State.
- B.4 The Committee approved and recommended the release of balance 50% of  $2^{nd}$  installment of ACA for Parole town as per the details at Annexure-IV.
- B.5 The proposal for <u>release of balance of enhanced ACA</u> for 15 IHSDP projects at Budgam (Housing), Reasi (Ph.I), Kupwara, Ramnagar (Ph.I), Sopore (Ph.I), Mattan (Ph.I), Bandipora, Baramulla, Magam (Ph.I), Ganderbal (Housing), Hajin (Ph.I), Handwara (Ph.I), Kulgam (Ph.I), Shopian (Ph.I) and Sumbal was discussed in the meeting. It was informed that these projects were approved in the CSC meeting held on 30.1.2009 with restriction of DU cost at Rs. 80,000/- per DU against the per DU cost of Rs. 1,25,000/- in all the 15 projects: It was further informed that in the 71<sup>st</sup> CSC meeting held on 18.12.2009, the Government had enhanced the Central share for unit cost of DU under IHSDP from Rs. 80,000/- to Rs. 1,00 lakh for all the IHSDP projects approved w.e.f. 1.4.2008 based on CCEA approval and decided to pass on the enhanced ACA for the benefit of projects where the unit cost approved was

\$ 60.

either equal to or more than Rs. 1,00,000 and the ceiling cost of DU was restricted to Rs. 80,000/-. The State Government of Jammu & Kashmir has drawn the restricted Central share and thus eligible for the enhanced ACA in respect of all the above 15 IHSDP projects.

B.6 Thereafter, the State representative made a detailed presentation on the progress of all the IHSDP projects. The Committee noted the physical and financial progress. The Committee asked the representative of the State Government to complete the projects as per the sanctioned covenant of the DPRs within the extended period. The Committee also noticed that 3 Pro-poor reform certificates in the prescribed formats for Budgam, Kupwara, Bandipora, Ganderbal, Hajin and Sumbal are yet to be received.

B.7 The Committee approved and recommended the release of enhanced ACA for 15 IHSDP projects at Budgam (Housing), Reasi (Ph.I), Kupwara, Ramnagar (Ph.I), Sopore (Ph.I), Mattan (Ph.I), Bandipora, Baramulla, Magam (Ph.I), Ganderbal (Housing), Hajin (Ph.I), Handwara (Ph.I), Kulgam (Ph.I), Shopian (Ph.I) and Sumbal as per the details at Annexure-V (Statement 1 to 15). However, the enhanced ACA will be recommended on receipt of 3 Pro-poor reform certificates in case of IHSDP projects at Budgam, Kupwara, Bandipora, Ganderbal, Hajin and Sumbal.

#### C Maharashtra

C.1 The proposal for curtailment of IHSDP Scheme of Kolhapur (Ph-I), Maharashtra was discussed in the meeting. HUDCO appraised the proposal. The committee was informed that the project was approved in 7<sup>th</sup> CSC meeting held on 08.12.2006 with a project cost of Rs. 2461.77 lakh and Central share of Rs. 1969.42 lakh. Due to beneficiaries reluctance to pay additional amount due to cost increase and for getting smaller houses, the ULB has revised the proposal with project cost of Rs. 860.67 lakh and Central share is Rs. 679.39 lakh. Thus, there is a saving of Central share of Rs. 1290.03 lakh. The details of the original vis-à-vis the revised project are as under:

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C.2 The Committee noted that in case of Kolhapur (Ph-I) project, against revised Central ACA of Rs. 679.39 lakhs, the State has drawn Rs. 984.71 lakhs lakhs towards 1<sup>st</sup> installment and the excess drawn Central ACA after curtailment comes to Rs. 305.32 lakhs. The Committee observed that if the project was initially proposed for 761 DUs, the Central ACA would have been Rs. 679.39 lakhs and Rs. 339.695 lakhs as 1<sup>st</sup> installment (50% of revised Central Share) for the project. Thus, the excess ACA drawn deemed to have been parked with the State Government. The Committee directed that the State Govt may credit the interest earnings on the ACA for ongoing project parked with them into the relevant account head meant for interest receipt of Government of India in order to bring back the same to Consolidated Fund of India, as per the provisions contained in the MoF, Deptt of Expenditure O.M. No 59(4) PF-1/2006 (Pt.) dt. 28<sup>th</sup> January 2013, a copy of which has also been circulated to all States/UTs vide MoHUPA's letter. No G-20011/1/2009-BSUP/JNNURM (part) (FTS-2930) dt. 18<sup>th</sup> February 2013.

C.3 The Committee approved curtailment of IHSDP project at Kolhapur (Ph.I) subject to furnishing SLCC approval for curtailment & authenticated copies of final DPR as per the details at Annexure-VI. The Committee advised the State to calculate the interest component on the excess ACA drawn by it against IHSDP project at Kolhapur and deposit the same with the Deptt of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance as per para C.2 immediately.

#### D Rajasthan

The proposal for deletion of 1 BSUP project at Begun was discussed in the meeting. It was informed that the project was approved in 127th CSC meeting held on 28.3.2012 subject to availability of Central ACA. At that time, there was no Central ACA available for this project as the State had exceeded the 7 Year ACA allocation for Rajasthan both under BSUP & IHSDP. However, the State Govt. took considerable time in proposing curtailment of 1 IHSDP project at Kota (Ph. I). The State Government proposed curtailment of 1 IHSDP project at Kota Ph. I with revised financial statement only in 139th CSC meeting held on 12th April 2013 making, availability of Central ACA. However, The State Level Nodal Agency, vide its Government of Rajasthan 6/RUIFDCO/IHSDP/2012-13/248 dated 8.4.2013 requested for de-sanction of 1 IHSDP project at Begun. The State Govt. has also informed that it will not be possible to complete this work within the extended Mission period.

D.2 The Committee accepted the request of the State Government and approved deletion/surrender of 1 BSUP project for Begun, Rajasthan subject to

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SLCC approval. The Committee also took note of the fact that no Central ACA was released for this project due to non-availability of Central ACA.

D.3 The Committee approved deletion of 1 IHSDP project at Begun, Rajasthan without any financial recovery as no Central ACA was released for this project. The Committee directed State Government to furnish SLCC approval for deletion of IHSDP project at Begun, Rajasthan.

#### **GENERAL OBSERVATIONS**

3. The Committee directed the Mission Directorate to recommend release of ACA to MoF/MHA as per the approval. The States/UT Governments are also requested to take necessary action on the observations of the Committee, furnish compliances and to make concerted efforts to complete the DUs along with infrastructure within the extended period of the Mission i.e. 31<sup>st</sup> March 2014.
