3. Based on decision of CSMC (RAY) in its 23rd meetings held on 20th September, 2016 and on the recommendations made by MoHUPA, the amount of ACA is being adjusted subject to the following conditions:

- This project shall be completed by March, 2017 as per commitment.
- Necessary sanctions/ approvals/ compliances required under the statutory or other regulatory regime as applicable would be obtained by the authority (ies) concerned with the project (s).
- The State Government and implementing agency shall put in place a monitoring system to ensure that the project (s) achieve scheduled milestone and envisaged outcomes including implementation of reforms and other conditionalities required under the scheme.

- (iv) Utilize the grant in accordance with the approved guidelines for the implementation of the Scheme of RAY and Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) - Housing for All (HFA) (Urban) Mission as well.
- (v) Furnish the Utilization certificates of the Grant released in the prescribed format as per GFR – 2005 as provided in the scheme guidelines.
- (vi) The funds may be utilized for the purpose for which these are given. Otherwise these will have to be refunded along with interest as per provisions for GFR-2005.
- (vii) Interest on unutilized ACA shall be charged from the date of release of the ACA till date of its final adjustment / recovery, from the State concerned.
- (viii) The State should prepare and submit a video documentary on the success story of the beneficiaries benefited in the project.

4. Payment may kindly be made to the State Government immediately. The funds may thereafter be released to the implementing agencies without any delay failing which the amounts would be recovered from the State Government with interest for the period of default.

5. The amount will be credited to the State Government's account in RBI as per procedure laid down by Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide O.M. No. F-II (45/76/SC) dated 22.02.1977.
