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Minutes of the 46th meeting of the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) - Housing for All Mission held on 29th August, 2019.

The 46th meeting of the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) [PMAY (U)] was held on 29th August, 2019 at 11.00a.m. in the Conference Room, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi, with Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs in Chair. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I**.

2. At the outset, the Secretary, Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA) welcomed the participants/representatives from the State Governments, participants/officers of the Ministry and other Departments. Following observations were made for compliance by all State/UTs Governments.

- i. In order to create awareness on the issues of water conservation, energy conservation, environment protection, waste management, health and hygiene amongst the beneficiaries of PMAY (U), the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has launched Angikaar (अंगिकार), an intensive campaign in all PMAY(U) cities on 29th August 2019. The purpose of this campaign is to converge with various urban Missions and other Ministries like Health & Family Welfare, Jal Shakti, Environment Forest & Climate Change, New & Renewable Energy, Petroleum & Natural Gas, Power etc. of the Government of India, to avail benefits of their schemes. This will facilitate PMAY (U) beneficiaries to not only get acclimatised to the new environment, but also adopt best practices and lead a healthy life while maintaining common infrastructure and basic civic facilities. It was reiterated that all State/UT Governments actively participate in the **Angikaar** campaign so as to provide a decent life to the PMAY (U) beneficiaries. The timelines of various activities:

- ii. The Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) has completed four years and many State Governments have shown remarkable progress in achieving Government of India's target for providing Housing for All by 2022. Given that more than 85 lakh houses have been sanctioned so far, the prime focus is now to complete the houses sanctioned as early as possible.
- iii. State/UT Governments should now get their demand saturated and send proposals for their remaining demand of housing under PMAY (U) for approval of CSMC latest by March, 2020 so that the houses sanctioned are progressively completed by 2022.
- iv. States/UTs must upload Online Monthly Progress Reports (MPRs) of all sanctioned projects in PMAY(U)-MIS latest by 10th of every month.
- v. CSMC is an apex Committee under Chairmanship of Secretary, MoHUA. Therefore, the Principal Secretary/Secretary/Mission Director looking after the PMAY(U) matters in the State/UT Governments should participate in the CSMC meetings. States/UTs should avoid deputing only Junior officials/Consultants etc. to attend CSMC meeting(s) as they may not have required information on policy level decisions and interventions required at the State/UT Government level.
- vi. With regard to unspent balance available with the State Governments, it was reiterated that para 14.7 of the PMAY (U) scheme guidelines allow State Governments to utilize the fund for other ongoing sanctioned projects of PMAY(U). Similarly, matching State/ULB share in the sanctioned projects under PMAY (U) may be released in time so that progress of construction of houses is not affected.
- vii. With respect to SLTC and CLTCs, States/UTs were advised to engage qualified and efficient professionals as per the capacity building financial guidelines and norms. This will help States/UTs in delivering quality output in PMAY (U) activities and monitoring.
- viii. Logo of the PMAY (U) scheme must prominently be displayed (stone plate embossed) in all houses constructed with Central Assistance under PMAY (U).
- ix. In some States/UTs, there are large numbers of completed houses which are lying unoccupied under JnNURM. In spite of repeated assurances given by the representatives of the State/UT Governments, these houses have not been allotted. All State Governments must ensure allotment and occupancy of these completed houses by end of October, 2019. Further, all excess Central Assistance lying with them for JnNURM projects must be refunded with interest immediately. Pending UCs under JnNURM and RAY should also be submitted without any further delay.
- x. State Government should appoint agencies to monitor and scrutinise the land issues and viability of the PMAY(U) scheme on ground for each vertical. It should be done zone wise. Mid Term assessment should also be taken under consideration for all the schemes under PMAY(U)

- xi. As announced by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India in his speech on 15th August, 2019 at Red Fort, Delhi, all State/UT Governments may encourage use of jute, cloth bags instead of plastic bags/polythene which are hazardous to our environment. State/UT Governments may take initiative by adopting environment friendly products made of paper, cloth, leaves etc. and avoid all type of plastic materials like water bottles, containers, seminar bags, glasses, pouches etc. in all meetings/seminars/canteens etc. Encouragement to small scale industry for preparation and marketing of jute/cloth bags may be given and strict enforcement of ban on plastic items for carry bags purposes may be ensured as per law.
- xii. The States/UT Governments must ensure compliance of relevant provisions of the RERA, Municipal Rules & Regulations/Laws, Building Bye-laws, Development Authority rules, installation of Rain Water harvesting system, Solar power system, etc. in the buildings constructed under AHP and ISSR verticals under PMAY (U). In addition, tree plantation, waste management and water conservation etc. may also be ensured in the vicinity of capital assets created under the PMAY (U). These have also been conceived in Angikaar initiative.

3. Thereafter, Joint Secretary and Mission Director (HFA) introduced the agenda for the meeting. The agenda items also form part of the minutes. The item-wise minutes are recorded as follows:

1	Confirmation of the minutes of the 45th meeting of CSMC under PMAY (U) held on 25.07.2019 (Agenda 1)
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a. The Committee was informed that in the 45th CSMC meeting held on 25.7.2019, the State Government of Uttar Pradesh had made a request for approval of 154 BLC (N) projects. However, as per agenda note, the projects mentioned were 138 and Minutes were accordingly prepared. The details of projects considered and approved in 45th CSMC stand revised as under:

2	Consideration for Central Assistance for 17 BLC (New) projects submitted by State of Arunachal Pradesh (Agenda 2)
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A. **Basic Information:**

The proposal for consideration for CSMC was for Central Assistance for 17 BLC (New) projects submitted by the State of Arunachal Pradesh. The salient details of the proposal are as under:

B. **Additional information by the State:**

i.	Demand survey is complete in all the 33 cities and total demand is 14,343 houses.
ii.	4 SLTC and 40 CLTCs professionals have been appointed and fully functional.
iii.	State Government has fixed a target for sanction of 9595 houses under PMAY (U).
iv.	PMAY(U)-MIS : Out of 4744 houses sanctioned under BLC, 4646 beneficiaries have been attached and 4199 houses are geo-tagged.
v.	Progress: Out of 4,744 BLC(N) houses sanctioned, work order has been issued for 4255 houses which are in different stages of construction. 1319 houses have been completed.
vi.	CLSS: 16 beneficiaries have availed interest subsidy.
vii.	For the construction of housing units, bamboo, timber and other eco-friendly building materials are being used.
viii.	Since the State falls under seismic zone-V, the RCC construction in columns, plinth beams and lintel beams have been adopted to mitigate catastrophe such as earthquake, flood etc.
ix.	HFAPoAs of 27 towns have already been submitted and approved by CSMC. HFAPoAs of 3 towns viz. Doimukh, Raga and Pangin have also been submitted for approval of CSMC.
x.	It was informed that as per PMAY (U) guidelines, State Government should release financial assistance to the beneficiaries in 3-4 instalments depending on progress of construction of the house. Beneficiary may start the construction using his own funds or any other fund and GoI assistance will be released in proportion to the construction by individual beneficiary. It has been noted that beneficiaries find it difficult to put in their own funds initially. As such, it was requested that State Government may be allowed to release funds to the beneficiaries of the BLC vertical as soon as Central Assistance is released to start work
xi.	JnNURM and RAY: The work of construction of houses and infrastructure under JnNURM and RAY is still undergoing. Projects in 3 towns will be completed by November, 2019 and rest in March, 2020. All the completed houses have been occupied

	under JnNURM.
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C. CSMC observations:

i.	The pace of construction is very slow. State needs to expedite construction and completion of houses approved earlier under PMAY (U).
ii.	As requested by State Government of Arunachal Pradesh and in view of special condition of the State, the CSMC allowed for release of funds to the beneficiaries to commence work in case of BLC vertical only. It was, however, advised that the State Government must ensure that funds released to the beneficiaries are used for house construction only.
iii.	Since the demand of houses is very less and only 50% of the demand has been met till date. State Government may propose all housing projects together by March, 2020.
iv.	State Government should look for way out to overcome land issue so as to provide housing for all in the State.
v.	The State has an unspent balance of Rs. 6.91 crore under PMAY (U) for which Utilization Certificates may be submitted at the earliest.

D. CSMC Decision:

In view of the above, the CSMC approved Central Assistance and recommended for release of first instalment of Central Assistance for the State of Arunachal Pradesh as under:

B. Additional information given by the State:

i.	Demand survey in 140 approved HFA cities/towns is in progress. As on date, validated demand is 5,04,893 houses.
ii.	Out of 2,52,703 BLC houses approved, 1,64,624 beneficiaries have been attached in PMAY (U)-MIS. Further, 72,619 houses have been geo-tagged.
iii.	Except Model Tenancy law, all mandatory reforms have been achieved.
iv.	HFAPoAs for 93 ULBS have been submitted, rest are in progress.
v.	Progress: Out of 2,52,703 houses sanctioned, work order has been issued for 1,06,144 houses out of which 28,316 houses have been completed and balance are at different stages of construction.
vi.	CLSS: 5,003 beneficiaries have availed interest subsidy.
vii.	All the houses under JnNURM and RAY will be completed and occupied by March, 2019.
viii.	CLTCs are functioning in all cities in the State.

C. CSMC observations:

i.	About 50% of demand of houses is yet to be proposed by the State Government. The State needs to develop housing projects under AHP and ISSR verticals of PMAY(U) as well. All houses must be sanctioned in the current financial year so that the same are completed within Mission period. State Government may consider involving all stakeholders viz. Housing Board, Collector, Mayors, Chairman, Nagar Panchayat/Nagar Palika etc. in identifying beneficiaries and submit housing proposals in order to meet housing demand in the State. Further, pace of houses construction may be expedited.
ii.	There is big potential of BLC projects in the State of Bihar. State Government may consider giving land 'patta' to the beneficiaries so that they can be included in the PMAY (U).
iii.	State Government should freeze the demand at the earliest and not keep it floating.
iv.	State Government may consider Mass Grounding Ceremony to commence construction of houses for all BLC houses in one go. This will help Government in proper and timely execution of all sanctioned projects.
v.	Geo-tagging of houses may be ensured for all sanctioned projects.
vi.	Adequate infrastructure such as individual water, sanitation and electricity connections and convergence of other Government of India/State Government schemes needs to be ensured by the State.
vii.	The completed Demonstration Housing Project constructed by BMTPC may be allotted as per revised DHP guidelines immediately.
viii.	The State has an unspent balance of Rs. 573.93 crore under PMAY (U) for which Utilization Certificates may be submitted at the earliest. Utilization Certificates for Rs. 26.62 crore under JnNURM and Rs. 80.94 crore under RAY may be submitted immediately. Further, excess Central Assistance of Rs. 45.50 crore under JnNURM may be refunded immediately.

ix.	MIS entry of all beneficiaries with valid Aadhaar be expedited to enable the Ministry to release balance of first instalment of Central Assistance to the State Government. State Government may also ensure that MIS entry is complete before seeking 2 nd instalment of Central Assistance in respect of sanctioned projects.
x.	JnNURM and RAY: 192 houses under JnNURM and 3,932 houses under RAY are reported as not-started, the same may be completed immediately. Further, all unoccupied houses may be occupied by October, 2019.

After deliberations, the CSMC approved Central Assistance and recommended for release of first instalment of Central Assistance for the State of Bihar as under:

B. Additional information given by the State:

i.	<p>Progress:</p> <p>ISSR- Of the 8 projects for 5,946 houses approved earlier, no houses have been grounded so far.</p> <p>AHP- Out of the 75,442 houses approved in 137 projects, 38,483 have been grounded of which 6,279 are complete. Work on 36,959 houses is yet to start.</p>
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	BLC- Out of the 1,44,950 houses approved in 1182 projects, 95,793 houses have been grounded for construction of which 30,104 houses have been completed, and the remaining are at different stages of construction. 49,157 houses are yet to start.
ii.	The State Government has launched State Awards – 2019 “Mor Pradarshan – Mor Samman” to encourage ULBs, stakeholders, beneficiaries etc. for successful and timely completion of sanctioned houses.
iii.	Under IEC activities, State Government has prepared for circulation in easy to understand language a booklet for BLC Component (Mor Jameen - Mor Makaam). The booklet cover all aspects of PMAY (U) viz. how to apply, eligibility of beneficiaries, release of funds in instalments, raw materials selection etc.
iv.	Overall, 93% of the beneficiaries under 3 verticals (BLC,AHP, and ISSR-PPP) have been attached in PMAY (U)-MIS. Further, 65% of BLC, 76% of AHP and 87% of ISSR-PPP projects have been geo-tagged.
v.	All the mandatory reforms under PMAY (U) have been implemented
vi.	JnNURM/RAY: About 4152 houses (2192 IHSDP, 1920 BSUP and 40 under RAY) are unoccupied which will be allotted soon.
vii.	Tenders have been invited for ISSR projects in Bilaspur and Raipur; however, no response has been received. The State Government is considering converting ISSR projects into BLC at the located sites.
vii.	Since the funds are diverted in many projects within vertical, State Government may be allowed to submit UCs on city basis and not on project basis.

C. CSMC observations:

i.	The Committee appreciated the efforts of the State Government in publishing booklet on PMAY (U) and desired that wide-spread circulation amongst beneficiaries may be ensured.
ii.	With regard to submission of UCs on city basis, it was clarified that in order to reconcile the fund released and UC received, the PAO, MoHUA accept the UCs based on sanction order in respect of the fund released in a project. Hence it is not feasible to accept UC on city basis. It was, however, directed that the matter may be taken up with IFD and PAO in the Ministry.
iii.	State Government may get approvals to cover the remaining demand by 31 st December 2019.
iv.	In order to attract builders for taking up ISSR project, State Government may consider giving more incentives by way of additional FAR/FSI, commercial utilisation of vacant space etc.
v.	State Government may consider involving Community Building Organisations (CBOs) to sensitize beneficiaries about the houses and infrastructure created, waste management, cleanliness, optimal utilization of resources available, saving water, etc.
vi.	The progress of AHP projects is not satisfactory. Out of 75,442 AHP houses sanctioned, only 38,483 houses have been grounded out of which only 6279 houses

	have been completed.
vii.	The State has an unspent balance of Rs. 537.25 crore under PMAY (U) for which Utilization Certificates may be submitted at the earliest. UCs for Rs.22.95 crore under JnNURM is also pending. The State should expedite submission of the pending UCs.
viii.	Out of 2,26,338 houses sanctioned earlier, beneficiaries attached with valid Aadhaar are 1,50,902. State to expedite all MIS entries and beneficiary attachment.
ix.	The State should submit HFAPoAs for all the cities approved under the Mission at the earliest.
x.	The State Government is yet to submit the copy of the SLSMC Minutes for the 24 AHP projects approved in 38 th CSMC.

5	Consideration for Central Assistance for 20 BLC (New) and 10 BLC (Enhancement) projects submitted by the State of Himachal Pradesh (Agenda 5)
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A. Basic Information:

i.	The Demand survey is complete in all the 54 cities approved under PMAY (U). There is slight increase in the demand assessed which is 18,377 houses now.
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ii.	54 HFAPoAs have already been noted by CSMC.
iii.	BLC (N) & BLC (E) : Out of 7914 approved houses, 5041 houses have been geo-tagged. Of these, 1211 houses have been completed and 1585 houses are at different stages of construction.
v.	CLSS: The Banks are insisting on collateral security for bank loan to the beneficiaries resulting in poor progress in availing of subsidy under CLSS by the beneficiaries.
vi.	State Government has reduced stamp duty from 4% to 3% for woman beneficiaries.
vii.	NIT Hamirpur has been engaged for earthquake safe structural designs for EWS house units in 3 different construction techniques i.e masonry, confined masonry and RCC & structural safety design specific to Earthquake Zone IV and V.
viii.	Himachal Pradesh being a hilly State, most of the land is in forest area which restrict construction of houses. A committee has been formed to look into the issues connected with availability of land from forest/adjoining areas for taking up construction projects for the beneficiaries.
ix.	JNNRUM and RAY: Some infrastructure work is still undergoing and there are some issues with the contractor in case of JnNURM projects, which is being looked into. State Government is trying hard to complete undergoing houses and allot the same to the beneficiaries.

iv.	All completed houses under JnNURM and RAY may be allotted before October, 2019 positively.

Utilization Certificates for Rs. 1.34 crore under JnNURM and Rs. 23.91 crore under RAY are pending. State should expedite submission of the pending UCs. Excess ACA of Rs. 2.99 crore released under JnNURM be also refunded immediately.

iii.	The State has achieved all the mandatory reform conditions.
iv.	The Progress is as under: BLC (N) and (E) – Out of 32,804 sanctioned houses, 8671 houses are in different stages of construction, whereas 3311 houses have been completed. AHP – Work is yet to start.
v.	CLSS: 483 beneficiaries have availed interest subsidy.
vi.	Some of the beneficiaries are not able to start construction due to lack of initial funds with the beneficiaries.
vii.	City/ Ward Level Consultation have been organised to convey PMAY(U) scheme benefits to the intending beneficiaries. Similarly pamphlet in local language and publicity through print and electronic media about the scheme has also been made on continuous basis.

ix.	It was informed that in case of BLC projects, beneficiaries find it difficult to put in their own funds initially. As such, it was requested that State Government may be allowed to release funds to the beneficiaries of the BLC vertical as soon as Central Assistance is released to start work.

C. CSMC observations:

i.	Bank linkage for beneficiary share may be explored so that houses which have not started due to lack of funds with the beneficiaries may be started.
ii.	The local administration may also propose housing projects in the Ladakh region (which has become a Union Territory) so that benefit of PMAY (U) is extended to this hilly region also. If required a team from Delhi may be sent to extend hand-holding for preparation of housing projects under PMAY (U).
iii.	All out efforts should be made so that the work on sanctioned houses is commenced at the earliest.
iv.	After bifurcation of Jammu & Kashmir, the demand of housing may be re-examined so that all eligible beneficiaries may avail the benefit of the scheme. A special drive for

	demand assessment may be carried out.
v.	The average State Share is very less. J&K Government may consider enhancement of its contribution for the PMAY (U) scheme for the benefit of beneficiaries in BLC component.
vi.	Since J&K is in the Seismic Zone V, adequate disaster resistant features need to be adhered to in all projects.
vii.	J&K has an unspent balance of Rs. 118.42 crore under PMAY (U) for which Utilization Certificates may be submitted at the earliest. Utilization Certificates for Rs. 37.81 crore under JnNURM and Rs. 5.3 crore under RAY crore are pending. State should expedite submission of pending UCs immediately.
viii.	Out of 33,812 houses sanctioned earlier, beneficiaries attached with valid Aadhaar are 25,917. The State should expedite all MIS entries and beneficiary attachment immediately.
ix.	JnNURM and RAY: 5,205 houses under JNNURM and 292 houses under RAY reported as not-started. State Government may refund the Central Assistance in respect of non-started houses of JnNURM immediately. Similarly work shown as under progress in case of JnNURM and RAY projects must be completed immediately.
x. iii.	Grounding of houses needs to be expedited so that the construction can be completed as per scheduled timeline. State Govt should at least complete 1 lakh houses in next three month.
iv.	Geo-tagging is very poor. As per records, out of 1,79,457 BLC houses approved, only 16,969 houses have been geo-tagged.
v.	Out of 8,31,904 houses sanctioned earlier, beneficiaries attached with valid Aadhaar are 1,90,454 only (23%). The State should expedite all MIS entries and beneficiary attachment.
vi.	The State has an unspent balance of Rs. 642.52 crore under PMAY (U) for which Utilization Certificates may be submitted at the earliest. Utilization Certificates for Rs. 283.97 crore under JnNURM are also pending. State should expedite submission of pending UCs.
vii.	JnNURM: 26,104 completed houses constructed under JnNURM are still vacant. These houses may be allotted to the beneficiaries of PMAY (U) after following due procedure. All the vacant houses must be allotted before October, 2019. In case of ongoing projects under JnNURM, the cost of which will have to be borne by the State/ULB/Implementing Agency as the scheme has ended on 31.3.2018. Further, the excess release of Rs. 224.41 crore under JnNURM may be refunded with interest immediately.
viii.	For AHP projects, State Government may place on record all required approvals from the concerned authorities in a time bound manner. Similarly, BIS standard and relevant provisions of NBC should be ensured in all projects. iv.	PMAY(U)-MIS : Out of 4,78,102 houses sanctioned under BLC, 4,27,664 beneficiaries have been attached and 3,38,916 houses are geo-tagged. In case of AHP, out of 1,36,977 houses sanctioned, 33,842 beneficiaries have been attached and 1,29,273 houses are geo-tagged.
v.	CLSS: Number of loans sanctioned under CLSS is 29,466. Rs. 511.67 crore as subsidy amount under CLSS vertical has been transferred to the beneficiaries.
vi.	In a few cases, BLC houses have been completed. The State Government representative requested that combined release of 2 nd and 3 rd instalment of Central Assistance may be considered for release in these cases.
vii.	At a number of locations, the number of houses are less than 250 houses mandated under AHP vertical of PMAY (U), which are part of the demand of the city under AHP vertical. The CSMC has been requested to relax the condition as per para 6.4 of the PMAY (U) guidelines to facilitate construction of houses.
viii.	TPQM reports have been submitted. The State has requested for early release of fund to

	complete the houses.
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C. CSMC observations:

i.	Details of the curtailment of houses as proposed and considered in 44 th CSMC may be sent so that the MIS data is revised and excess Central Assistance, if any, is adjusted against ongoing projects.
ii.	Beneficiary contribution is on higher side. The State should ensure consent of the beneficiaries in this regard.
iii.	Logo of the PMAY (U) scheme may suitably be displayed in all houses constructed with Central Assistance under PMAY (U).
iv.	JnNURM & RAY: 1881 houses in JnNURM are lying vacant. The State should take necessary action immediately so that vacant houses are occupied without any further delay. Further Central Assistance of Rs. 67.52 crore excess released under JnNURM should be refunded with applicable interest immediately.
v.	The State is required to take necessary measures to ground all the non-started projects immediately.
vi.	Out of 6,15,079 houses sanctioned earlier, beneficiaries attached with valid Aadhaar are 4,54,350. The State should expedite all MIS entries and beneficiary attachment.
vii.	The State has an unspent balance of Rs. 668.39 crore under PMAY (U) for which Utilization Certificates may be submitted at the earliest. Utilization Certificates for Rs. 0.98 crore under JnNURM and Rs. 3.65 crore under RAY are also pending. The State should expedite submission of the pending UCs.
viii.	1 st instalment of Central Assistance for AHP projects will be released on confirmation by State Government about selection of Developer for the projects, registration of the projects under RERA, and that work order has been issued.
ix.	The State has submitted SLAC and SLSMC approval for 216 BLC projects for 39,849 and 11 AHP projects for 1093 houses. The State is to provide SLAC and SLSMC approval for 30 BLC projects for 10,575 houses and 4 AHP projects for 788 houses in due course.

D. CSMC Decision:

- accorded relaxation as per the provision at para 6.4 of PMAY (U)-HFA guidelines in respect of the AHP project having less than 250 houses; and

The Committee was informed that HFAPoAs for the UTs of Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Jammu & Kashmir and States of Odisha, Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh have been submitted to the Ministry after approval from the respective State Level Sanctioning and Monitoring Committees (SLSMCs) as per PMAY (U) guidelines. On the basis of provisions of the PMAY(U) Scheme guidelines and approval of SLSMCs of the concerned States/UTs, the HFAPoAs from 230 cities from the above States and UTs were placed before CSMC for information and record as per the following details:

B. Additional information given by the State:

i.	The demand survey is completed in all 164 approved Mission Cities. The total demand of houses is 3.48 lakh.
ii.	Progress: BLC: 45,429 houses have been sanctioned out of which 23,599 houses have been grounded. 2831 houses (BLC) have now been completed and occupied. AHP: 570 houses have been sanctioned. None of the house has been constructed
iii.	CLSS: 9915 beneficiaries have availed interest subsidy.
iv.	JnNURM: All the unoccupied houses have been allotted.
v.	Minutes of the SLSMC meeting will be sent soon.
vi.	State Government will propose more BLC projects in order to meet its housing demand.

C. CSMC observations:

i.	The sanction vis-a-vis demand of houses submitted by the State Government is poor. Against projected demand of 3.48 lakh, Central Assistance for only 56,939 houses has been sanctioned. State Government may take sincere efforts so that the poor gets housing benefit under PMAY (U).
ii.	Disaster resilient construction may be ensured in all the projects.

iii.	The State Government may ensure valid ownership of land lies with the beneficiaries.
iv.	The State has to expedite the geo-tagging and beneficiary attachment in MIS
v.	During the CSMC meeting, it was clarified that HFAPoAs should be reviewed on yearly basis to make changes in already submitted HFAPoAs in view of implementation of AIP in the preceeding years. The charges will be reimbursed as per PMAY (U) guidelines only once.
vi.	The State has an unspent balance of Rs. 160.88 crore under PMAY (U) for which Utilization Certificates may be submitted at the earliest. Utilization Certificates for Rs. 19.90 crore under JnNURM are also pending. The State should expedite submission of the pending UCs.
vii.	Out of 47,024 houses sanctioned earlier, beneficiaries attached with valid Aadhaar are 38,413. The State should expedite all MIS entries and beneficiary attachment immediately.

D. CSMC Decision:

In view of the above, the CSMC approved Central Assistance and recommended for release of first instalment of the Central Assistance for the State of Punjab as under:

13	GENERAL OBSERVATIONS
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- States/UTs should ensure that the **PMAY (U) logo** is displayed in front of all housing units constructed under funding support of the Government of India. However, State/UTs should not display any such information which may amount to violation of Model Code of Conduct (MCC) as per instruction issued by the Election Commission of India/State Election Commissions from time to time.
- State Governments may prepare short films, printed literature/documents on projects undertaken under PMAY (U) to showcase how lives of beneficiaries have transformed. It should be widely circulated both in print and electronic media and also in various social media platforms for generating awareness. The State Government should also share with the Ministry high resolution photographs and video testimonials of beneficiaries whose houses have been completed.

- iii. The State/UT Governments should consider ISSR component of PMAY (U) for rehabilitation of slums by using land as a resource and which is available with the State/UT/ULBs.
- iv. The Central funds in general and EBR funds in particular released under PMAY(U) mission should be passed on to the ULBs/Implementing Agencies within the time frame stipulated in the respective sanction orders and registration of all ULBs on PFMS may be ensured by all State/UT Governments. This is a very important matter hence appropriate arrangements and safeguards must be built in. The EBR fund is an interest bearing fund and it is important that the funds so released to the State do not remain parked with SLNA/State Government, but is utilized on fast pace for the purpose it has been released. Any interest earned on the parked fund will be adjusted/ recovered against subsequent instalments in the sanctioned projects under PMAY (U).
- v. With regard to the vacant houses, if any, under JnNURM, the State Governments/UTs should look for realistic, pragmatic options so as to allot these houses to eligible beneficiaries in urban areas without any further delay.
- vi. A robust MIS System being critical for PMAY (U) Mission. States need to constantly monitor the linking of beneficiaries to sanctioned projects in PMAY (U)-MIS. All States/UTs to ensure that the Aadhaar details of beneficiaries with regards to their number and name is accurate while updating in MIS.
- vii. Under PFMS/DBT process, the funds would have to be transferred at every stage only through electronic mode for Beneficiary Led individual house Construction (BLC) under PMAY (U). The bank account details of the beneficiaries should necessarily be mapped so that the funds can flow to the beneficiaries' bank account directly. There should also be 100% Aadhaar linkages of beneficiaries in all AHP, BLC, ISSR and CLSS cases.
- viii. States/UTs need to expedite grounding of approved projects so that they are completed within the timeline.
- ix. The States/UTs should submit project proposals for consideration of CSMC by **15th of each month** so that site scrutiny/desk scrutiny in respect of identified DPRs can be done before the CSMC holds meeting.
- x. HFAPoA should have been submitted prior to bringing project proposals for that city. If not, justification for delay should be provided.
- xi. The State/UT Governments may make provision of cistern in toilet, two platforms in kitchen, cemented almirah/slab, storage space in living room, loft, etc. which are basic requirement for a family. Similarly, plantation drive may be organised on completion of construction work especially in AHP and ISSR projects to increase green cover at the locality.
In BLC projects, houses should be constructed little away from the existing road, wherever possible, for better planning and ease of traffic movement. It was reiterated that PMAY (U) addresses the aspiration of human being for a better and dignified life. All out efforts should be made to provide maximum facilities.
- xii. Housing demand along with infrastructure in aspirational districts to be prioritised and completed immediately.
- xiii. The State/UT governments may consider G+7 units under AHP and ISSR projects with lift facility as land is a scarce resource. The maintenance cost of the lift can be managed by the resident welfare society once houses are occupied.

- xiv. States/UTs should implement innovative, cost effective and high quality construction technologies for constructing the housing units under PMAY (U) and document the same. The tender documents should preferably be technology neutral and a clause of quality assurance for the potential bidders should be included.
- xv. First instalment of Central Assistance in case of BLC/ISSR projects shall be released on the basis of Aadhaar seeded beneficiaries in PMAY (U)-MIS.
- xvi. Further, the first instalment of Central Assistance in respect of ISSR and AHP projects shall be released on confirmation from the State/UT Government(s) about selection of Developer and issuance of work order. With respect to AHP projects, the 2nd instalment of Central Assistance shall be released after Aadhaar seeding of all beneficiaries is completed in the project and entered in PMAY (U)-MIS by the State/UT Governments.
- xvii. State Level Appraisal Committee is expected to thoroughly appraise the DPRs before submitting the same to State Level Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee for approval. Combining SLAC and SLSMC meeting is not permissible as the mandate of the two bodies is distinct.
- xviii. Allotment of houses in AHP and ISSR vertical of PMAY (U) should be Aadhaar enabled, provision for which has already been made in PMAY (U)-MIS.
- xix. State/UT Governments are advised to ensure that:
 - a. Adequate infrastructure is provided including individual water, sanitation and electricity connections.
 - b. There should be no duplication/change in the identified beneficiaries
 - c. Demarcation of land and mutation is carried out before implementation
 - d. The design and construction of houses is disaster resilient and the specifications conform to IS/ NBC norms.
- xx. The MoHUA has formulated 'PPP Models for Affordable Housing' to enable States/UTs to facilitate private sector participation, in order to meet the growing need of affordable housing in the country. The States/UTs are advised to make use of these guidelines suitably for PPP projects on affordable housing.
- xxi. It has come to notice that some individual/organizations are collecting registration money etc. from potential beneficiaries seeking dwelling units in PMAY (U) fraudulently. The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has not authorized any individual/organization/agency to collect application/registration fee for applying for houses in PMAY (U). Thus, no individual/agency/organization can collect any money/application fee from the beneficiary for enrolment under PMAY (U). All State/UT Governments may also issue disclaimer to this effect in their relevant websites/advertisements etc. to stop this kind of fraudulent activity.
- xxii. The Ministry has launched a PMAY (U) Mobile App to enable beneficiaries to upload their photos with their house and a video clip where beneficiaries share experience of owning a house under PMAY (U) as testimonials. The App can be downloaded from Google Play Store. The State/UTs may inform their beneficiaries to upload the same using this Mobile App.
