Minutes of the 7th CSSC Meeting

7th meeting of the Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals of cities under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme.

7th meeting of Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) was held at 11:00 AM on 14th March 2024, in Committee Room, 5th floor, Transport Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals received from the States/Cities under PM-eBus Sewa Scheme. The list of participants is attached (Annexure-I)

2. Director (UT) welcomed all the Members of the CSSC and made a brief presentation on the proposal of cities as recommended by Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee (PMEC) in its meeting held on 11th March and 13th March 2024.

3. The proposals of 5 cities for 290 buses were discussed and sanctioned as per the details given below, subject to submission of necessary undertakings as per the scheme.

4. Behind-the-meter power infrastructure proposals: The proposals of 10 depots from 7 cities of 4 States (Maharashtra, Odisha, and Punjab) for Behind-The-Meter (BTM) power proposals were presented. Based on the deliberations held during the meeting, the Committee sanctioned the proposals of 10 depots of 7 cities as per the details given below.

Observation of the committee are as follows:

- The parking area for charging of buses should be able to accommodate maximum number of buses which can be charged by the installed chargers.
- Proposals for both the depots of Vasai-Virar have been approved, however city may be advised to review the area requirement for holding 60 buses in Navghar depot and 40 buses in Nalasopara depot.

5. Civil infrastructure of Bus depot: The proposals of 15 cities from Maharashtra, Haryana, Jammu and Kashmir, Assam, Punjab, Meghalaya, and Odisha for Depot civil infrastructure were presented before the committee. Based on the deliberations during the meeting, the Committee sanctioned the proposals of 15 cities as per the details given below.
