



**MINUTES OF THE 164<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF THE CENTRAL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE (CSC) OF THE INTEGRATED HOUSING AND SLUM DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (IHSDP) UNDER JAWAHARLAL NEHRU NATIONAL URBAN RENEWAL MISSION (JNNURM)**

Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi, 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2015

The 164<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Central Sanctioning Committee (CSC) of the Scheme on Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) was held on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2015 at 3.00 p.m. in Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi with Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation in the Chair. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I**. Joint Secretary & Mission Director welcomed Secretary, Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation and Chairperson CSMC and informed that the CSMC is examining UCs submitted by State/UTs for release of next installments in the projects under JNNURM. It was further stated that all the ongoing projects sanctioned upto 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2012 need to be fully completed within the extended period i.e. by 31.3.2017. Following directions were reiterated:

- i. **States shall submit Utilization Certificates for ongoing projects for claiming balance ACA or adjustment of excess ACA. Any unadjusted excess ACA needs to be refunded to Government of India with interest at applicable rate.**
- ii. **States should not make any adjustment of excess ACA lying with them on their own without specific sanction of CSMC/CSC. Mission Directorate shall ensure that the installments sanctioned in the CSMC/CSC meetings are either adjusted against excess unutilized ACA lying with the concerned State/UT or released expeditiously.**
- iii. **States are requested to send project completion certificates expeditiously for the completed projects.**

2. CSC considered following proposals as per agenda note and presentations made by the State officials. Minutes are recorded in the alphabetical order of names of States.

3. The Minutes of the 163<sup>rd</sup> CSC meeting held on 17.9.2015 were confirmed.

**4. Rajasthan**

**4.1 Curtailment of 160 DUs in 3 IHSDP projects at Asind, Chabra and Sangod town**

4.1.1 In the absence of any representative from the State Government, Dy Secretary (HFA-III) presented the proposal for curtailment of DUs. It was informed that the State Government of Rajasthan has proposed curtailment of 83 DUs in Asind, 61 DUs in Chabra and 16 DUs in Sangod IHSDP

projects. On curtailment of these DUs, Rs. 1.44 cr. of ACA will be reduced in these projects calculated on proportionate basis as per details hereunder:

The excess ACA released in these projects will be adjusted in ongoing projects or recovered with interest.

**4.1.2 The Committee approved curtailment of 160 DUs in these 3 IHSDP projects and directed that excess ACA, if any, may be recovered/adjusted against ongoing projects.**

## **5 Tamil Nadu**

**5.1 Proposal for balance of enhanced ACA of 2<sup>nd</sup> and final installment of ACA in 19 IHSDP projects.**

5.1.1 The Committee was informed that in 81<sup>st</sup> CSC meeting dated 27.4.2010, ACA for DUs sanctioned for the IHSDP projects in the State of Tamil Nadu was revised from Rs. 80,000/- to Rs. 1.00 lakh per DU in 52 projects. Accordingly, 50% of the enhanced ACA of 1<sup>st</sup> installment was released. Now the Govt. of Tamil Nadu has furnished UC for 19 IHSDP projects and requested for release of balance of enhanced ACA of 2<sup>nd</sup> & final installment of ACA.

5.1.2 The Committee was also informed that while sanctioning balance 50% of 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of Kancheepuram project in the 114<sup>th</sup> CSC meeting held on 21.10.2011, cost of works of water supply and storm water drain was reduced and it was directed that proportionate central ACA towards cost reduction of Rs. 2,11,200 be made. Therefore, enhanced fund for Kancheepuram project cannot be allowed.

5.1.3 **The Committee approved and recommended release of enhanced Central ACA of Rs. 186.99 lakhs (excluding Kancheepuram) as per details in Annexure-II.**

## **6 Proposal for revision of IHSDP projects due to curtailment of DU/Infrastructure/change in quantities**

6.1 The Committee was informed that due to paucity of time available for completion of projects under JNNURM (which was to expire on 31.3.2015), the CSMC approved dropping of non-starter DUs in 150<sup>th</sup>, 157<sup>th</sup>, 158<sup>th</sup> and 160<sup>th</sup> meetings and ACA on dropped DUs and infrastructure was calculated on proportionate basis to adjust ACA lying with the State/UTs against

ongoing projects. The JNNURM Mission has now been extended upto 31.3.2017 for completion of ongoing projects. States have sent revised ACA calculations for ongoing projects due to curtailment of DUs for approval of CSMC. These revised costs have been recommended by appraisal agencies. The details of original, revised DUs as well as revised ACA of 7 IHSDP projects are as under:
