The 9th meeting of Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) was held at 11:30 hours on 22nd July 2024, in Committee Room, 5th floor, Transport Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals received from the States/Cities under PM-eBus Sewa Scheme. - 2. Director (UT) welcomed all the Members of the CSSC and made a brief presentation on the proposal of cities as recommended by 15th, 16th, 17th and 18th Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee (PMEC) in its meetings.

For the BTM proposals of Raipur and Durg-Bhilai in the State of Chhattisgarh, the Secretary directed to review techno-economic feasibility of the proposed substations based on the information provided on the PM-Gati Shakti portal. This required information was explored on the PM-Gati Shakti portal, and it was found that the locations of the substations 132/33 kV as suggested by DISCOM (CSPDCL) are not mapped on the portal. However, the techno-economic feasibility was carried out for alternate locations near the proposed depots based on the coordinates furnished by the cities of Raipur and Durg-Bhilai as tabulated below.




