Monthly summary on the principal activities of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the month of December, 2019

I. Swachh Bharat Mission

- i. 1.60 crore citizens are registered on the Swachhata App, 1.83 crore complaints have been registered out of which more than 93 % complaints have been resolved.
- ii. On Swachh Bharat Helpline (1969), for all issues related to Swachh Bharat, 5.14 lakh calls have been answered with an average handling time of 1 minute 28 seconds.
- iii. A total of 4,320 cities/ towns has been declared as ODF (Open Defecation Free), 937 cities have been certified as ODF+ and 328 cities have been certified as ODF++. An ODF++ city requires to achieve sanitation sustainability by addressing complete sanitation, including safe containment, processing and disposal of faecal sludge and septage.
- iv. 57,000 toilet across 2,500 cities are live on Google Maps with the name of "SBM Toilet" covering 55% of urban population.
- v. 114 cities have been registered on Swachh Nagar Mobile App so far.
- vi. As on date 9,000 Garbage Vulnerable Points (GVP) have been mapped, out of which 1,224 are being monitored. 385 cities comprising of 2,330 active wards are using this module. The Swachh Survekshan 2020 has a dedicated indicator on monitoring and transformation of GVPs.
- vii. The number of cities with 5 Star Certification is 4, 3 Star Certification is 57 and 1 Star Certification is 4 under Star Rating Protocol for Garbage Free Cities.
- viii. The results of Swachh Survekshan League 2020 (Quarter 1 and Quarter 2) were announced by Shri Hardeep S. Puri, Hon'ble Minister of State (I/C) for Housing and Urban Affairs, on 31 December 2020. Secretary, MoHUA, made a presentation on Swachh Survekshan's journey and the key indicators for SS 2020. Swachh Survekshan 2020, the fifth edition of the annual urban cleanliness survey conducted by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) scheduled to commence from 4 January 2020 across India, was also rolled out on the occasion. The performance of cities in SS League 2020 is crucial to their ranking in Swachh Survekshan 2020.
- ix. In order to showcase the transformational experience of the beneficiaries of SBM(U) with the viewers of its show 'New India Sankalp',

Doordarshan invited Swachhagrahis of SBM-U for a panel discussion with Secretary, MoHUA and National Mission Director – SBM (U).

x. Earlier only statutory towns and notified planning development areas have been included under Swachh Survekshan (SS) 2020. Now areas falling within notified Planning/Special Area Development Authority (SDA)/ Urban Development Authority or any such Authority under State legislation entrusted with the functions of urban planning and regulations have also been included in the same.

xi. A series of Exposure Workshops in partnership with National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA) has been organised in 26 locations for the period of October to December, 2019 to spread awareness about issues and challenges in of Solid Waste Management (SWM), Faecal Sludge and Septage Management (FSSM), Wastewater and sustainable sanitation. By the end of December, 2019, 550 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) have participated with more than 1,012 participants in the 30 workshops over 250 ULBs.

II. Smart Cities Mission

i.Work has been completed in 134 projects worth Rs. 988 crore, work was started for 70 projects worth Rs. 1,796 crore and tenders was issued for 70 projects worth Rs. 2,437 crore. With this, 4,354 projects worth Rs. 1,53,825 crore have been tendered, work orders have been issued for 3,548 projects worth Rs. 1,08,324 and 1,461 projects worth Rs. 24,467 crore have been completed.

III. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

i.State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) have been approved for all the States for Rs. 77,640 crore. Out of these, work has been completed for 2,384 projects worth Rs. 8,419 crore, contracts have been awarded and work in progress for 2,923 projects worth Rs. 64,213 crore and remaining projects are in Detailed Project Report (DPR)/ tender stage.

ii. So far, Rs. 24,352.10 crore has been released to States/UTs towards project implementation, Administrative & Office Expenses, Reform Incentive and for formulation of GIS based Master Plans & Local Area Plan (LAP) and Town Planning Schemes (TPS).

IV. Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana / National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY/NULM)

i.A total of Rs. 12.69 crore has been released during the month.

ii.11,044 Self Help Groups (SHGs) were formed, 6,492 SHGs were given Revolving Fund, 24,474 candidates were skill trained and certified, 9,611 trained candidates were given placement, 15,008 beneficiaries were assisted with loans for setting up of individual and micro enterprises, and 22,174 loans were given to SHGs under SHG-Bank linkage programme.

iii.National Consultation Workshop on DAY-NULM Pakhwada - Shehri Samriddhi Utsav 2020 was organized at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.

V. Pradan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)/ Housing for All (HFA)

- i. A total of Rs. 5730.37 crore has been released during the month.
- ii. Since the inception of the Mission, it has achieved milestone of sanctioning more than 1 core houses against the validated demand of 1.12 crore houses. 60 lakh houses have been grounded for construction of which 32 lakh houses have been completed.
- iii. 1,499 proposals from participating States for the construction of 6,40,672 houses with an overall investment of Rs. 27,839 crore involving central assistance of Rs. 9,610 crore were considered. The number of houses approved were 6,40,672.
- iv. A booklet "Urban Transformation through Housing for All" was released which captures the achievements and initiatives taken up by the Mission.

VI. Housing

- i.30 States/ UTs have notified rules under RERA; 4 North Eastern States namely Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland and Sikkim are under process to notify the rules under RERA.
- ii.30 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Regulatory Authority (Regular 23, Interim 07).
- iii.25 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Appellate Tribunal (Regular -17, Interim 08).
- iv. Regulatory Authorities of 25 States/UTs have operationalized their websites under the provisions of RERA.
- v.2867 complaints have been disposed off in month of December across the country. So far, 34,896 complaints have been disposed off by the Real Estate Regulatory Authorities across the country.
- vi.1079 projects and 701 agents have been registered in month of November, 2019 across the country. So far, 48,181 projects and 37,865 agents have been registered under RERA.

VII. NBCC

i.NBCC (India) Ltd. signed an MoU with Odisha Thermal Power Corporation Limited (OTPC) on 11.12.2019 to carry out construction and development works for 3800 MW Thermal Power Plant of OTPCL.
