(M. Jayachandran) Deputy Director (BSUP) MINUTES OF THE 37th MEETING OF THE CENTRAL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE (CSC) OF INTEGRATED HOUSING AND SLUM DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (IHSDP) UNDER JAWAHARLAL NEHRU NATIONAL URBAN RENEWAL MISSION (JNNURM)

The 37th meeting of the Central Sanctioning Committee (CSC) of Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation in New Delhi on 30th July, 2008. List of participants is at Annexure – I.

- 2.1. Joint Secretary (JNNURM) welcomed the participants. He informed the Committee that last year the overall performance was very To sustain the performance States/ULBs have to speed up activities for early completion of projects. He informed the Committee that some of the States/ULBs had demanded for Central assistance for meeting escalation in the cost. He requested the States/ULBs/Appraisal Agencies to ensure that all the projects for which Central assistance is sought have been prepared as per the latest SOR to obviate underinvoicing leading to cost escalation. Any escalation shall be borne by the He requested the States/ULBs to come up with new States/ULBs. projects along with request for 2nd/3rd/4th instalments. He also requested the States/UTs to come up with proposals (containing details of requirement of Central assistance) to be placed before the 13th Finance Commission.
- 2.2. Joint Secretary (JNNURM) and Mission Director requested the States/ULBs to make use of the online data entry facility of the JNNURM MIS. Financial and physical progress of all projects under BSUP and IHSDP should be put on the JNNURM tracking system. If necessary, a training programme on MIS/online management of data can be conducted based on the requirement of the State/ULB implementing agencies.

- 2.3. JS (JNNURM) also drew attention of the States/ULBs/implementing agencies to the following:-
 - Capacity Building Activities: In the year 2006-07, the Ministry of HUPA had released fund to the State Governments for capacity building activities including Research and Training towards implementation of BSUP and IHSDP projects. Unless the States submit utilisation certificates for the funds released earlier, further release of Central Assistance would be held up, as utilisation certificates have to be furnished within 12 months from the date of closure of the financial year to which financial sanction pertains.
 - Status of Project Implementation: The States/ULBs should present Quarterly Progress Reports/Monthly Progress Reports before bringing proposals to the Central Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee/Central Sanctioning Committee. Further, one page abstract on the status of implementation of projects & reforms must be presented before presenting the project proposals in the meetings of Central Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee/Central Sanctioning Committee.
 - Setting up of PMU/PIA/PIU:-The States should submit proposals to the o/o OSD (JNNURM) which will get the same appraised; and bring up before the Central Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee/Central Sanctioning Committee.
 - Fees for Preparation of DPRs: The States should submit proposals to the concerned Appraisal Agency which had appraised the projects. The Appraisal Agency has a crucial role in examining the claim with particular reference to the various stages of improvement and modifications that were brought out in the DPRs before they were finally approved by the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee/Central Sanctioning Committee. The Appraisal Agency will submit proposals to the Ministry for releasing Central Assistance towards the cost of preparation of DPRs (both in the case of DPRs prepared by inhouse personnel as well as by consultants). These will be considered by the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee. After approval, recommendation will be sent to Ministry of Finance/Ministry of Home Affairs for releasing

Central Assistance out of the ACA allocation for the particular State/UT in the case of projects prepared by consultants. The Central Assistance for DPRs prepared through in-house personnel of the States would be released from out of the 1% JNNURM fund in the Budget of Ministry of HUPA as decided in the Central Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee/Central Sanctioning Committee meetings earlier.

- Community Development Network (CDN): The State should prioritise and get necessary approval from SLSC/SLCC to the proposals related to Community Development Network (CDN). Such proposals received in the Ministry of HUPA will be appraised by a team working under the GOI-UNDP Project on National Strategy for Urban Poor coordinated by the National Project Coordinator/Deputy Secretary (JNNURM). The reports will then be placed before the Central Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee.
- Status report on already sanctioned projects: In all meetings, before new projects are taken up, a status report on already sanctioned projects should be brought up before the Committee. This should cover physical and financial progress of projects, utilization of funds and reforms. The States should submit Quarterly Progress reports and brief Monthly Progress Reports, as per prescribed format, without fail to enable the Ministry to report to Prime Minister's Office in time.
- 3.1. In his opening remarks, Chairman, CSC requested the States/ULBs to establish PMUs and PIUs in all States/cities. Similarly, all efforts should be made to institute Third Party Inspection and Monitoring (IPIM) mechanism to bring transparency and quality in the implementation of BSUP and IHSDP projects. The Ministry would give necessary assistance to the States for TPIM. Toolkit has been prepared and communicated to the State Governments.
- 3.2. Chairman, CSC and Secretary (HUPA) reiterated the need for giving special emphasis on the following:-
- (a) Quality of Projects: Housing for the poor does not mean poor quality housing. Utmost emphasis must be given to the quality of

houses for the poor. A vector-free atmosphere and healthy living environment should be ensured in the housing projects under BSUP/IHSDP.

- (b) Socio-economic Survey: No efforts should be spared for conducting socio-economic surveys of potential beneficiaries including preparation of bio-metric cards. Such surveys should emphasize housing, health, educational and livelihood profiles of the urban poor. The survey would assist in designing good BSUP/IHSDP projects by taking into account important aspects such as dependency load in the existing schools and hospitals, need for multi-purpose community centres including livelihood centre and informal sector market. HUDCO and BMTPC have developed good designs of houses and various types of social infrastructure which could be appropriately used while formulating project proposals. A Toolkit has also been published.
- (c) Convergence of Health, Education and Social Security: It is necessary to integrate provisions of Health, Education and Social Security with Housing for the Poor to enable them to lead a better quality of life. The Urban Local Bodies and the State Governments have a critical role to play to ensure proper convergence of facilities under the already available schemes for education, health and social security implemented through different departments/fields. The projects should list out the deficiencies in terms of access to school, primary health centre, provision of social welfare measures so that timely remedial measures in accordance with the socio-economic survey can be taken up.
- (d) Community Development Network. The dynamics of the CDN should lead to fraternity with the neighbourhood so that the issues of alienation of all sorts are eliminated. CDN should work towards better inter- and intra- relationships in colonies to get over the dividing forces. This will strengthen a feeling of solidarity among the residents.
- (e) Projects for in-situ development: States should come up with projects for in-situ development with good lay-outs and designs. The emphasis should be to provide a better and supportive atmosphere of living. The in-situ development should not end up with creation of another cluster of houses without access to water, sanitation and social infrastructure.

- (f) Sense of belongingness: To create a sense of belongingness, the slums may be named in consultation with the intended beneficiaries. Provision of a low cost enclosure around a slum pocket being covered under BSUP/IHSDP could be considered by a State/ULB in the interest of safety and a sense of local identity, if the cost is not prohibitive.
- (g) Three reforms core to the urban poor: special attention should be paid for implementation of the three reforms stipulated under JNNURM that are critical to the urban poor: (i) internal earmarking within local body budgets for basic services to the urban poor; (ii) provision of basic services including the 7-point charter in accordance with agreed timelines; (iii) earmarking at least 20-25% of developed land in all housing projects (both public and private agencies) for EWS/LIG category with a system of cross subsidization. The poor are squeezed out of the urban land market and the issue of land for housing the poor and informal sector activities and security of land tenure must be accorded top-most priority by the State Governments.
- 3.3. Chairman, CSC said that in all the meetings of CSMC/CSC/review meetings, emphasis is placed on the need to bring proposals for release of 2nd/3rd instalments based on the actual progress on the ground and utilization of Central Share, State Share and ULB share. States should come up with proposals in the prescribed format for second and subsequent instalments for already sanctioned projects. Release of funds for sanctioned projects and completion thereof should be accorded Top Priority. Central share along with State share should be released to ULBs within 2-3 days from the date of receipt of ACA. Any delay on this account would result in delay in the completion of projects which would put the poor beneficiaries under undue hardship.
- 3.4. Chairman, CSC also drew attention of the States/UTs towards the Prime Minister's New 15-Point Programme for the Welfare of the Minorities. An important objective of the new programme is to ensure that the benefits of various government schemes for the underprivileged reach the disadvantaged sections of the minority communities. In this regard, care should be taken to take up clusters of minority beneficiaries to the extent possible. Wherever feasible, efforts should be made to allocate upto 15% of targets and

outlays under BSUP and IHSDP for the minorities. Similarly, priority should be given to accommodate physically challenged beneficiaries.

- 3.5. The following issues, raised in previous meetings, directly related to improving the quality of life of the urban poor, were reiterated by the Chairman, CSMC:-
 - In case there is time constraint, a regular socio-economic survey can be preceded by a rapid survey for identifying beneficiaries, their main and subsidiary occupations, their educational profile and felt-needs so as to design appropriate social infrastructure for each project. Willingness of the beneficiaries should also be taken for any rehabilitation/relocation projects.
 - Affordability of the urban poor should be kept in view while working out Beneficiary Contribution. Overall construction cost of the housing unit should be kept at a minimum. The housing component should generally be at least 50% of the total project cost with a view to giving primacy to provision of shelter to the urban poor except where housing units have already been constructed/are being constructed under VAMBAY or other EWS scheme of Central or State Governments. Further, considering the difficulties and special needs of the urban poor at some locations, clusters having 15 housing units can also be considered.
 - Each project should be accompanied by a list of beneficiaries based on a socio-economic survey and ULBs should go for bio-metric cards, wherever feasible, to avoid the possibility of sale/misuse of housing units allotted to properly targeted beneficiaries. The list should be notified and placed in the website of the ULB/JNNURM.
 - The layout plan must be socially cohesive and facilitate social interaction. Efforts may be made for providing at least 30% open spaces with 15% green area in the lay-outs and adequate social and livelihoods infrastructure.
 - Adequate space must be provided for community activities, informal sector markets, livelihood activities, pen for animals (if permitted and required), space to take care of convergent services such as health, education and recreation conforming to the specific needs of each of the slum pockets and their beneficiaries.

- The houses proposed should have two rooms, balcony, kitchen and separate bathroom and latrine, individual water connection and sewer connection. Aspects such as storage space for keeping things in rooms/kitchen, location of kitchen, location of toilet and bathroom in the houses to facilitate privacy, independent access from both rooms to toilet and bathroom, leaving a small space for fitting exhaust fan in kitchen and toilet, balcony for drying clothes etc., are some of the nuances that can be thoughtfully incorporated in the design of the houses for the poor.
- The State authorities/ULBs may adopt some of the innovative designs and layouts of houses, multi-purpose community centres, informal sector markets and animal pen, etc., prepared and compiled by HUDCO and BMTPC. The Toolkit published may be referred to.
- The State authorities in consultation with appraisal agencies should ensure that necessary clearances such as environmental clearance, Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) regulation clearance, land use clearance, etc., are obtained. They should also ensure that necessary technical approvals are secured from the competent agencies as per State PWD Code.
- Since these projects are required to be generally completed in 12 to 15 months, it is generally expected that any escalation of the project cost is borne by the State Government/ULB concerned.
- Wherever informal sector markets are taken up as a part of social infrastructure, their operation on a time-sharing basis by inhabitants for enabling wider coverage of the beneficiaries can be considered by the ULB concerned.
- Adequate provision should be made for solid and liquid waste disposal and digester technology can be adopted in place of dualpits/septic tanks wherever feasible.
- Road-side plantations with tree guards are advisable.
- Responsibility of the technical specifications (adherence to State PWD Code) and their approval by the competent authority lies with the ULBs/State Level Nodal Agency. The appraisal agencies must ensure that technical specifications are duly approved by the technically competent authority.

- 4. For the Meeting, 31 new project proposals from the States of Kerala (2 projects), Maharashtra (4 projects), Uttar Pradesh (15 projects) and West Bengal (10 proposals) were put up in the agenda. Also a proposal for release of 2nd instalment for 7 IHSDP projects in Uttar Pradesh were put up in the agenda. Brief details of the agenda are at **Annexure-II.**
- 5. The Chairman, CSC requested the representatives of the State Governments to give an account of the following:-
 - (i) Brief details of physical and financial progress of already approved projects including the actual availability of Central share, State share, ULB share, beneficiary contribution, and loan component; tentative schedule for seeking 2nd instalment of Central share; number of houses actually constructed; stage of progress of housing and infrastructure, reforms etc.;
 - (ii) Basic details of the present proposals such as total project cost and its break up into housing and infrastructure components (percentages); break-up of cost of housing and infrastructure under Central Share, State share, ULB share, Beneficiary contribution, loan, contribution by parastatals if any; and
 - (iii) Design of colony layout and house layout proposed.
- 6. Representative of the State Government of Kerala made a presentation on two projects. The Committee observed that the layout plans of the projects need to be modified to include social and utility infrastructure facilities and adequate space. **Accordingly, the proposals were deferred.**
- 7.1. Four projects were presented by the representative of the State Government of Maharashtra. The Committee appreciated the layout plans and building designs for the proposed projects. The Committee suggested that the duration of the projects (for Gangapur and Georai) needs to be reduced from the proposed 18 months to 15 months.
- 7.2. The State agreed to reduce the duration of the projects from 18 months to 15 months. Accordingly, the CSC approved the proposals and

the abstracts of the approved projects are at Statement-I to IV of Annexure-III.

- 8.1. The Committee then considered 15 projects which were presented by the representative of the State Government of Uttar Pradesh.
- 8.2. No information on livelihood details of the proposed beneficiaries for Behraich project was furnished. For the project for Saraimeer adequate open space has not been provided. The representative of the State Government sought time for furnishing requisite information and for modification in the layout/design. Accordingly, these two projects (Behraich and Saraimeer) were deferred.
- 8.3. In respect of the remaining 13 projects, the Committee observed the following:-
 - Design of livelihood centre needs to be improved keeping in view the insights gained from socio-economic surveys of the proposed beneficiaries;
 - Estimate of animal pen (based on plinth area) needs to be prepared on the basis of latest schedule of rates;
 - Design of the informal sector market needs to be revised to provide adequate space and ventilation for the vendors;
 - For the Khanpur project, no provision has been made for park in the pocket of proposed 72 dwelling units. This needs to be re-looked; and
 - For the Pachperwa project, layout plan needs to be modified by re-arranging building block;

The CSC approved the projects subject to above conditionalities.

- 8.4. The appraisal agency (HUDCO) has informed the following:-
 - (i) The design of livelihood centre has been modified and revise cost estimates have been incorporated in the financial statements;
 - (ii) The design of the animal pen has been modified based on latest schedule of rates and revised cost estimates have been incorporated in the financial statements;



- (iii) Slight modification has been made in the design for informal sector market to provide adequate space and ventilation, without changing the cost estimates proposed under DPR;
- (iv) The State has given an undertaking that there is an existing park at a distance of ½ to 1 km. from the pocket of the proposed 72 dwelling units in Khanpur IHSDP project;
- (v) The layout plan for Pachperwa project has been modified;
- (vi) The total project cost has marginally increased for the projects for Nandgaon, Chattari, Khanpur, Raya, Chhata, Gokul and Hariharpur. SLCC approval is required for the same.
- 8.5. Abstracts of the 13 approved projects are at Statement-V to XVII of Annexure-III. First instalment of Central share for the projects for Nandgaon, Chattari, Khanpur, Raya, Chhata, Gokul and Hariharpur will be released on receipt of SLCC approval for the upward revised project cost.
- 9.1. The Committee then considered 10 project proposals presented by the representative of the State Government of West Bengal. He requested that for the projects for Kurseong, Mirik and Kalimpong in the Darjeeling district, Central share may be provided at 90% of the project cost as the proposed site is at hilly and difficult area.
- 9.2. The Committee decided that for the housing units in hilly and difficulty areas in the Darjeeling District of West Bengal, Central share will be @ 80% of the admissible unit cost with 12.5% additionality as per the IHSDP guidelines.
- 9.3. The CSC approved the proposals subject to the following conditionalities:-
 - Digester facility may be provided wherever felt feasible and desirable for sewage disposal in the projects; and
 - For the projects for Kandi, Kaliyaganj and Contai, SLCC approval has to be obtained.
- 9.4. The State has informed that SLCC approval for the projects has now been obtained. They have also informed that the twin leach pit system for sewage disposal has now been proposed in most of the slums.

However, based on the success of digester facility in select slums, the same will be replicated in other slums also. Abstracts of the approved projects are at Statement XVIII to XXVII.

- 10.1. Deputy Secretary (JNNURM) presented the proposal for releasing 2nd instalment for 7 IHSDP projects in Uttar Pradesh. He informed the committee about the status of release and utilisation of Central share/State and progress in implementation of reforms.
- 10.2. Chairman, CSC, emphasised that the States/ULBs must implement reforms as per the targets in MoΛ and any delay in that should be addressed immediately. He also reiterated that the project has to be executed as per sanctioned DPR and any escalation in cost on that account would be borne by the State/ULB.
- 10.3. The Committee approved the proposal for releasing the 2nd instalment of Central assistance for these projects. **Details of the approved 2nd instalment are at Annexure-IV.**
- 11. JS (JNNURM) and Mission Director requested the representative of Department of Expenditure to invariably mark a copy of the sanction letter releasing Central share for BSUP and IHSDP projects to the nodal officer for BSUP and IHSDP projects in the concerned States to enable them to track the release of Central assistance on time.
- 12. OSD (JNNURM) drew attention to para 4 of the minutes of the 36th meeting of CSMC held on 7.4.2008 and said that the appraisal agencies have not yet submitted project related documents to NBO which is the custodian of records of JNNURM. Chairman, CSC, and Secretary (HUPA) directed NBO to inform the status of submission of such records by the appraisal agencies within a fortnight. The documents should include original DPRs, revised DPRs, appraisal reports, financial and physical abstracts. All the relevant pages of the documents should bear signature of the authorized officer of the appraisal agency. Appraisal agencies should give high priority to this work to enable the Ministry to respond to queries under RTI, any reference from C&AG, or any other query.

- 13. Chairman, CSC directed OSD (JNNURM) to send notices to all the Regional Chiefs of HUDCO to attend CSMC/CSC meeting for projects relating to the region they represent. Their inability to attend and explain the projects would be reported to CMD, HUDCO, for appropriate action.
- 14. Concluding the meeting, the Chairman of CSC and Secretary (HUPA) drew attention towards the benefit of bringing out a City Poverty Reduction Strategy Report. The city of Rajkot (Gujarat) has brought out such a Report which could be a model for other cities/towns. He once again urged the States/UTs/ULBs/parastatals (e.g., Development Authority)/implementing agencies/appraisal agencies to adhere to the guidelines as well as undertake measures for smooth implementation of the projects to benefit urban poor.
