Monthly summary on the principal activities of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the month of July, 2019

I. Swachh Bharat Mission

- i. 1.56 crore citizens are registered on the Swachhata App, 1.77 crore complaints have been registered out of which 93 % complaints have been resolved by end of this month.
- ii. Rs. 17.63 crore has been released to the States during the month.
- iii. On Swachh Bharat Helpline (1969), for all issues related to Swachh Bharat, more than 4.90 Lakh calls have been answered with an average handling time of 1 minute 27 seconds.
- iv. 'Swachh Manch' is the citizen engagement platform where 1,09,730 events are posted, 1 crore people participated and 2,600 ULBs are on board.
- v. 45,000 toilet blocks across 1,700 cities are live on Google Maps with the name of "SBM Toilet".
- vi. In order to achieve garbage free cities which involves the elimination of Garbage Free Points (GVPs), a GVP/Black Spot app has been developed. This app provides an integrated solution for monitoring all GVPs across the city. As of now, 3,500 GVPs have been mapped across 1200 wards on the GVP app.
- vii. Garbage Free Protocol (GFC) Workshop was held in Mumbai to provide an overview of the GFC protocol & address key concerns faced by Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in Maharashtra. The purpose of workshop was to briefly describe the modified GFC protocol, assessment format, marking scheme, Dos and DONTs and various common issues faced by ULBs.
- viii. A Capacity Building Workshop was organized in Ranchi for all 42 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) of Jharkhand. Some of the topics covered included the modalities of Swachh Survekshan League 2020, Garbage Free Protocol, as well as success stories in sanitation and solid waste management from all over the country.

II. Smart Cities Mission

- i. Work has been completed in 24 projects worth Rs. 171 crore and work was started for 33 projects worth Rs. 1,361 crore. With this, 946 projects worth Rs. 15,160 crore have been completed, 1,951 projects worth Rs. 76,773 crore are currently under implementation and 810 projects worth Rs. 44,526 crore are under tendering.
- ii. Data Assessment Maturity Framework: To create a culture of using Data in planning and management of cities the Data Maturity Assessment Framework (DMAF) has been framed. The intent of DMAF is to provide a

comprehensive set of indicators to help assess each city's readiness towards data.

- iii. ClimateSmart City Assessment Framework: The Framework is first-of-its-kind public assessment framework on climate relevant parameters. The objective is to provide a clear roadmap for the cities and in effect, urban India as a whole, towards combating Climate Change while planning their actions within the city including investments. The ClimateSmart Cities assessment framework consists of 30 diverse indicators across five categories namely; (i) Energy and Green Building, (ii) Urban Planning, Green Cover and Biodiversity, (iii) Mobility and Air Quality, (iv) Water Resource Management and (v) Waste Management.

III. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

- i. State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) to the tune of Rs. 77,640 crore have been finalized for all the States. Detailed project reports for projects costing Rs. 80,395 crore have been approved. 1,746 projects worth Rs. 4,422 crore have been completed, contracts have been awarded for 3,216 projects worth Rs. 61,623 crore and 316 projects worth Rs. 8,313 crore are under tendering and DPRs worth Rs. 7,559 crore are under preparation.
- ii. So far, Rs. 20,968.53 crore has been released to States/UTs towards project implementation, Administrative & Office Expenses, Reform Incentive and for formulation of GIS based Master Plans.

IV. Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana / National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY/NULM)

- i. 10,661 Self Help Groups (SHGs) were formed, 5,612 SHGs were given Revolving Fund, 5,315 candidates were skill trained and certified, 3,744 trained candidates were given placement, 5,313 beneficiaries were assisted with loans for setting up of individual and micro enterprises, and 6,506 loans were given to SHGs under SHG-Bank linkage programme.

V. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)/ Housing for All (HFA)

- i. A total of Rs. 183.07 crore has been released during the month.
- ii. 85.12 lakh dwelling units in 17,605 projects with an investment of Rs. 5,03,704 crore involving Central assistance of Rs. 1,32,458 crore have been approved under PMAY. So far, 50,17,423 houses have been grounded for construction, 26,37,300 houses have already been constructed and 23,96,999 houses have been occupied.
- iii. The release of grant was approved for the States of Assam, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Haryana, Rajasthan, and Uttar Pradesh.

Housing

- i. 30 States/ UTs have notified rules under RERA; 4 North Eastern States namely Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland and Sikkim are under process to notify the rules under RERA.
- ii. 29 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Regulatory Authority (Regular - 20, Interim - 09) (Lakshadweep is under process).
- iii. 22 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Appellate Tribunal (Regular - 13, Interim - 09).
- iv. Regulatory Authorities of 24 States/UTs have operationalised their websites under the provisions of RERA.
- v. 785 projects and 743 agents have been registered in month of July, 2019 across the country.
- vi. Manipur has established the Real Estate Regulatory Authority and Real Estate Appellate Tribunal in July, 2019.

VI. Others

- i. The Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorised Occupants) Amendment Bill, 2019 was passed by Lok Sabha.
