Monthly summary on the principal activities of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the month of March, 2018

I. Swachh Bharat Mission

- i. Minister of State (IC) Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs interacted with local Swachhagrahis at a Swachhata Symposium in Bengaluru on 17 March 2018.
- ii. MoS (IC), H&UA released guidelines on 'Empowering Marginalised Groups – Convergence between Swachh Bharat Mission and Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana -National Urban Livelihood Mission' at a National workshop organized in New Delhi on 23 March, 2018.
- iii. Memorandum of Understanding between Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) and 3Wayste regarding setting up of 500 TPD Waste to Energy plant and between BBMP and Nexus Novus Private Limited regarding setting up of 600 TPD Waste to Energy plant were signed.
- iv. 1,945 cities/towns, including 121 cities/towns during the month, have been declared Open Defecation Free (ODF) so far through third party certification.
- v. ₹488.51 crore has been released to the States during the month.
- vi. 78.89 lakh citizens are registered on the Swachhata App. 1.32 crore complaints had been registered of which 1.26 crore complaints were resolved by the end of the month.
- vii. A month-long thematic drive on 'Women and Sanitation' was conducted across all ULBs and states to commemorate International Women's Day on 8 March 2018.

II. Smart Cities Mission

- i. So far 90 Smart Cities, including two cities of Round 3 namely Aizwal and Saharanpur during this month have incorporated city level Special Purpose Vehicles (SPVs).
- ii. ₹520 crore has been provided through final batch of Supplementary Demand for Grants and released to 28 cities of Round 3 and 1 city of round 4 as part of first year instalment.

- iii. A loan agreement of EUR 100 million was signed between the French Development Agency AFD and the Government of India under the Indo French partnership programme during the French President's visit. This loan agreement would provide for a credit facility for at least 15 Smart City Projects selected through an All India Challenge process.

III. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

- i. State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) have been finalized for all the States to the tune of ₹ 77,640 crore (4,672 projects). 350 projects worth ₹ 263 crore have been completed and in case of 1,857 projects worth ₹ 36,661 crore, work is in progress. 1,880 projects worth ₹ 26,155 crore are under tendering.
- ii. ₹ 9,120 crore (including Rs.1,023 crore in March, 2018) has been released to States/UTs against their approved State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs).
- iii. A scheme regarding incentives to Urban Local Bodies, which are covered under AMRUT, for issuance of Municipal Bonds was announced and informed to all States/UTs.

IV. Heritage Cities Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY)

- i. National Film Development Corporation has been assigned the task of preparing 2-5 minutes films on the 12 Heritage Cities.
- ii. A total of ₹21 crores was released for various projects under HRIDAY Scheme.

V Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana / National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY/NULM)

- i. Swachhata Excellence Awards were distributed to Area Level Federations (ALFs) of various States on 23 March 2018 by Minister of State (IC) H&UA.
- ii. Systematic Progressive Analytical Real-time Ranking (SPARK) system was developed for inter-se ranking of the States to foster a competitive spirit amongst the States/UTs and boost the performance. Madhya Pradesh, Chhatisgarh and Kerala were

recognized and awarded by MOS(IC)H&UA for securing first, second and third ranks respectively.

iii. A total of ₹ 243.07 crore was released during the month under various scheme under the Mission.

VI Pradan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)/ Housing for All (HFA)

- i. Release of Central grant for the States of Bihar, Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Mizoram, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal has been approved.
- ii. 44.36 lakh dwelling units in 9,121 projects with an investment of ₹ 2,50,977 crore involving Central assistance of ₹ 68,416 crore have been approved under PMAY(U). So far, 22.11 lakh houses have been grounded for construction and construction for 4 lakh houses have been constructed and 3.56 lakh houses have been occupied.
- iv. An amount of ₹10,719.61crore have been released to the States during the month.

VII. Urban Transport

21.56 Km length of metro rail from Majlis Park to Durgabai Deshmukh South Campus Section, which is a part of 58.59 km long Pink Line (Line 7) from Majlis Park to Shiv Vihar of Delhi Metro Rail Corporation Phase III has been opened for public carriage of passengers. This section will provide direct interchanges at Azadpur with Line-2 (Yellow Line), Netaji Subhash Place with Line-1 (Red Line) and Rajouri Garden with Line-3 (Blue Line).

VIII NBCC (India) Ltd.

- i. Subsequent to CCEA's in principle approval for Strategic Disinvestment of CPSEs and NBCC's willingness to takeover few CPSEs, NBCC has participated in the Preliminary Information Memorandum for strategic disinvestment floated by DIPAM through YES Bank.
- ii. NBCC (India) Ltd. has diversified into Road Sector by signing a MoU with EDCUL to construct a 50 Km four lane eco-tourism circuit along Kotdwar-Ramnagar Kandi Road in Uttarakhand.
- iii. NBCC (India) Ltd. signed an MoU with Rural Electrification Corporation Ltd. (REC) for the construction of 'REC Township' at Gurugram.
