Minutes of 105th CSMC Meeting held on 24th February, 2012

105th CSMC was held on 24th February 2012 under the Chairmanship of Secretary (UD), Government of India. The proposal for release of 2nd installment to Meghalaya Govt. (Shillong mission city) for purchase of buses for urban transport system under JnNURM was taken up in the CSMC meeting.

- 2. List of the participants is at Annexure.
- 3. The CSMC considered the appraisal note from Institute of Urban Transport (IUT) forwarded by UT wing.
- 4. Release of 2nd instalment to Meghalaya Shillong
- 4.1 Under this scheme, a total of 120 buses were sanctioned for the city of Shillong in CSMC meeting held on 29.05.2009, as per the details given in the table below:

- 4.2 Urban Affairs Department, Government of Meghalaya submitted DPR phase II alongwith a note for the release of the 2nd installment. The DPR and the note have been examined and accordingly following observations are made:
 - It is noticed that no progress has been made on the ITS. Information on PIS, onboard cameras, integrated controller need to be provided on each bus at the earliest.
 - Four LEDs are to be provided; on front, rear, side and in the bus. The LED should mention the route name and number both in Local language and English alternatively. The LED inside the bus should mention details of next stop. The same must be announced in the bus which will help visually disabled commuters.
 - A route map of bus routes should be provided in the bus and also at each bus shelter.
 - The formula for periodic revision of fare must be worked out and shared with the Ministry.
- 4.3 in addition to above mentioned points, OSD(UT) & e.o. JS stated that action on the following points must also be taken before the release of final installment:

- a) The city must subscribe to National Public Helpline and Common Mobility Card-"More".
- b) Progress on various reforms, complied to, has to be submitted to Ministry.
- c) Registration number and photographs of buses in running condition for all the buses (in soft copy) must be submitted to the Ministry at the earliest.
- d) The payment to the manufacturers by the city/para statal should be made and must not be linked with the sanctioning of instalments by The Ministry of Urban Development (JnNURM). The city must release the payments once the buses have been received as per the finalized payment schedule.
- 4.4 Considering the fact that out of 120 buses sanctioned to the city of Shillong, 60 buses (50 Mini and 10 standard buses) had been delivered in Dec., 2011 and payment of Rs.57967174/- had been made to the manufacturers and the remaining 60 buses are expected to be delivered by March 2012, the CSMC after detailed deliberations decided to release up to 75% of ACA of 60 buses to be received and 90% of ACA of 60 buses which are now operational. The next installment of ACA works out as follows:-
