I. Swachh Bharat Mission

- i. 4,369 cities/ towns have been declared as ODF (Open Defecation Free) out of which 4,295 cities have been certified through third party verification. 3,071 cities have been certified as ODF+ and 951 cities have been certified as ODF++. An ODF++ city requires to achieve sanitation sustainability by addressing complete sanitation, including safe containment, processing and disposal of faecal sludge and septage.
- ii. 65,519 toilets across more than 3,196 cities are live on Google Maps with the name of "SBM Toilet".
- iii. Swachhata App emerged as an important tool to handle queries specific to Covid 19. The Ministry announced the launch of a revised version of the existing Swachhata-MoHUA App in order to enable citizens to get their COVID related complaints also redressed by their respective Urban Local Bodies(ULBs). The Swachhata App has a total of 1.82 crore users, who have posted 2.31 crore complaints, of which 2.17 crore complaints have been resolved, with a resolution of above 93%.
- iv. Under Safaimitra Suraksha Challenge (SSC), Ioan melas were organized at Mumbai (involving 20 ULBs) on 4th July 2021, at Rajamahendravaram in Andhra Pradesh on 19th July 2021, at Ahmedabad in Gujarat on 28th July 2021, at Puri and Rourkela in Odisha on 29th and 30th July 2021 respectively and at Mira Bhayandar in Maharashtra on 30th July 2021.
- v. Under SSC, skill development trainings of Safaimitras have been conducted in 64 cities till date across the states of Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Chhatisgarh, Haryana, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Punjab, Tamilnadu and Uttar Pradesh. 8,366 Safaimitras, including informal workers, have been provided on field training on 'Recognition of prior learning' model, over last 6 months.
- vi. In the month of July 2021, 9 of the 12 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) of West Bengal declared themselves Open Defecation Free (ODF). These include Bidhan Nagar, Siliguri, Dhupguri, Raiganj, Kaliaganj, Jalda, Haora, Raghunathpur, and Haringhata. MoHUA will now initiate the process of third-party verification for these 9 ULBs. Only three ULBs, Asansol, Puruliya and Kolkata, are left to be declared ODF from the State.
- vii. Digital Platform was developed by MoHUA for Monitoring of Community and Public Toilets (CT/PTs). This platform will enable citizens to provide feedback on the cleanliness of the CT/PTs
- viii. Notable Information, Education and Communication (IEC) campaigns launched during the month.

- Campaigns were undertaken on International Plastic Bag Free Day, 3rd July and World Nature Conservation Day, 28th July to spread awareness on how conservation of natural environment can be done through small steps such as adopting the 3R principle, waste segregation, saying no to single use plastic bags which in turns leads to a Swachh (clean) and Swasth (healthy) India.
- A social media campaign titled 'Badhte Chalo Swachhata Ki Nayi Manzilon Ki Ore' was run on social media to highlight the noteworthy achievements of SBM-U in the last six and a half years.

II. Smart Cities Mission (SCM)

- i. During the month 224 projects worth ₹ 5,064 crore have been completed and work has been started on 185 projects worth ₹ 2,578 crore. So far 6,154 projects worth ₹1,82,346 crore have been tendered and work orders have been issued for 5,506 projects worth ₹ 1,50,393 crore out of which 2,921 projects worth ₹ 50,730 crore have been completed.
- ii. Secretary, MoHUA, announced the top 11 winning cities in first stage of India Cycles4Change Challenge during an online event held on 28 July 2021. The award marked the start of the next stage of the first season of India Cycles4Change Challenge where 107 cities across the country came together to test, learn, and scale up different cycling-friendly initiatives, kick-starting India's cycling revolution. The event was attended by officials from Central and State Governments, Smart City CEOs and other stakeholders from cities participating in India Cycles4Change Challenge. The event also marked the release of the first Challenge report, and an Online Exhibition showcasing cities cycling journey.

III. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

- i. State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) have been finalized for all the states for ₹77,640 crore. As on date, Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) have been approved for the projects costing ₹81,551 crore. Some States have taken up projects in excess of their approved SAAPs. Entire excess amount in such cases will be borne by the States/ULBs. Works have been completed for 3,648 projects worth ₹20,082 crore and work is in progress for 2,105 projects worth ₹60,423 crore. In all, physical work worth about ₹54,000 crore has been carried out in completed/ongoing AMRUT projects implying that around 70% of physical work has been completed.
- ii. So far, ₹32,547 crore has been released to States/UTs towards project implementation (including the eligible projects of erstwhile JnNURM), Administrative & Office Expenses (A&OE), reform incentive, and under subschemes on 'Formulation of GIS based Master Plans in AMRUT cities' and 'Local Area Plan (LAP) and Town Planning Schemes (TPS)' in 25 selected cities.

IV. Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana /National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY/NULM)

- i. 11,092 Self Help Groups (SHGs) have been formed; 4,035 SHGs were given Revolving Fund; 6,090 candidates were skill trained and certified; 1,817 trained candidates were given placement; 7,370 beneficiaries were assisted with loans for setting up of individual and micro enterprises and 5,274 loans were given to SHGs under SHG-Bank linkage programme.
- ii. Under PMSVANidhi, 43,48,629 applications have been received against which 25,88,220 sanctions and 22,95,931 disbursals have been made.
- iii. A total of ₹ 62.74 crore has been released during the month under DAY-NULM scheme.
- iv. Since March, 2021 around 20,000 SHGs have produced and supplied approximately 1.17 crore face masks, 10 lakh PPE kits and 1.83 lakh litres of sanitizers across States/UTs.

V. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)/Housing for All (HFA)

- i. Since the inception, Mission has sanctioned 1.13 crore houses, out of which 84.94 lakh houses have been grounded for construction. So far, more than 50 lakh houses have been completed/delivered.
- ii. A total of ₹155.68 crores have been released under PMAY-U 'Housing for All' mission during the month.

VII. Housing

- i. All States/ UTs have notified rules under RERA except Nagaland which is under process to notify the rules.
- ii. 30 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Regulatory Authority (Regular 25, Interim 05).
- iii. 28 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Appellate Tribunal (Regular -22, Interim 06).
- iv. Regulatory Authorities of 27 States/UTs have operationalized their websites under the provisions of RERA.
- v. So far, 70,764 complaints (including 2,229 complaints during the month) have been disposed of by the Real Estate Regulatory Authorities across the country.
- vi. So far, 67,844 real estate projects and 52,472 real estate agents have been registered under RERA. 2,457 real estate projects and 936 real estate agents have been registered during the month.
