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

## Annexure

### **Monthly summary on the principal activities of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the month of May, 2023.**

#### **I. Swachh Bharat Mission**

- i. All 4,715 cities/ towns have been declared as ODF (Open Defecation Free) of which 4,355 cities have been certified through third party verification, 3,547 cities have been certified as ODF+, 1191 cities have been certified as ODF++ and 14 cities (Indore, Surat, New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC), Tirupati, Chandigarh, Navi Mumbai, Vijayawada, Hyderabad, Greater Visakhapatnam, Karad, Panchgani, Bhopal, Baramati and Mysore) have been certified as Water+.
- ii. 67,407 toilets across more than 3,326 cities are live on Google Maps with the name of "SBM Toilet".
- iii. Swachhata App emerged as an important tool towards enabling citizens to have their grievances addressed by the concerned Municipal Corporation. The Swachhata App has a total of 2.08 crore users, who have posted 2.55 crore complaints, of which 2.39 crore complaints have been resolved, with a resolution of above 94%.
- iv. The result of GFC 2022 was declared on 01st October 2022 as part of the Swachh Survekshan Award Ceremony 2022. The number of cities with 7-Star Certification is 1, 5-Star Certification is 11, 3-Star Certification is 199 and 1-Star Certification is 234 under Star Rating Protocol for Garbage Free Cities(GFC).
- v. MoHUA signed an MoU with RITES LIMITED on 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2023 for technical assistance for SWM & UWM under SBM-U 2.0.
- vi. Hon'ble Minister, HUA launched 'Meri LiFE, Mera Swachh Shehar' campaign for a period of 3 weeks in collaboration with the Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change in which more than 17,000+ RRR Centres have been established and 25 lakh citizens have come together to contribute to the Centres.
- v. 6th Swachh Talks webinar series organised on 26th May, 2023 on the topic of 'Clean Cities for Clean Rivers'.

## **II. Smart Cities Mission (SCM)**

- i. 7,865 projects worth ₹180,176 crore are ongoing, of which 5,773 projects worth ₹ 1,07,531 crore have already been completed.
- ii. A meeting of the Consultative Committee of the Parliament for the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs was held on May 22, 2023 at Panaji, under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister of Housing & Urban Affairs. The presentation highlighted the various aspects of the Smart Cities Mission that included the diversity of the projects as per the aspirations and needs of the citizens, the outcomes of various projects undertaken under the Mission that have impacted the citizens, use of technology in urban management and key learnings from the Smart Cities Mission.
- iii. A Meeting of Indian cities with members from the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA i.e. represents public finance officials throughout the United States and Canada) was held as an Introduction to the GFOA and it's structure, and to start a discussion on creating a similar organization for finance experts in India.
- iv. The 2nd Peer Learning Workshop was conducted on 18<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 in Rourkela, bringing together 10 winning cities Bengaluru, Hubli-Dharwad, Greater Warangal, Indore, Jabalpur, Kakinada, Kochi, Kohima, Rourkela, and Vadodara under the Nurturing Neighbourhoods Challenge. Participants also visited projects in Rourkela developed under the Nurturing Neighbourhoods Challenge,

## **III. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)**

- i. State Annual Action Plans(SAAPs) have been finalized for all the states for ₹77,640 crore. As on date, Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) have been approved for the projects costing ₹83,428 crore. Progress in implementation of AMRUT: Some States have taken up projects in excess of their approved SAAPs, wherein excess amount will be borne by the States/ULBs. Works have been completed for 4,946 projects worth ₹38,152 crore & work in progress for 952 projects worth ₹44,739 crore. In all, physical work worth about ₹71,768 crore has been carried out in completed/ongoing AMRUT projects implying that around 92% of physical work has been completed.

- ii. So far, ₹38,134 crore has been released to States/UTs towards project implementation (including the eligible projects of erstwhile JnNURM), Administrative & Office Expenses (A&OE), reform incentive, and under sub-schemes on 'Formulation of GIS based Master Plans in AMRUT cities' and 'Local Area Plan (LAP) and Town Planning Schemes (TPS) in 25 selected cities'.
- iii. Seventh meeting of Apex Committee for AMRUT 2.0 was held with States/ UTs on 1st May 2023 under the chairmanship of Secretary, HUA

**IV. Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana /National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY/NULM)**

- i. During the month of May of current financial year 6,622 Self Help Groups (SHGs) have been formed; 2,179 SHGs were given Revolving Fund; 3,723 beneficiaries were assisted with loans for setting up of individual and micro enterprises and 6,274 no. of loans were given to SHGs under SHG-Bank linkage programme.

**V. PM Street Vendor's Atma Nirbhar Nidhi (PMSVANidhi)**

- i. Under PM Street Vendor's Atma Nirbhar Nidhi (PMSVANidhi), 65,66,351 applications have been received against which 48,53,365 sanctions and 46,58,390 disbursals have been made.
- ii. A total of Rs. 56.7 Lakh have been released under the mission during the month of May, 2023.

**VI. Pradan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)/Housing for All (HFA)**

- i. Since the inception, Mission has sanctioned 1.20 crore houses of which 110.72 lakh houses have been grounded for construction of which 74.51 lakh houses have been completed/delivered.

**VII. Housing**

- i. All States/UTs have notified rules under RERA except Nagaland, which is under process to notify the rules.
- ii. 32 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Regulatory Authority (Regular - 26, Interim - 06). *Ladakh, Meghalaya and Sikkim have notified the rules while yet to establish Authority.*
- iii. 28 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Appellate Tribunal (Regular -24, Interim - 04) (*Arunachal Pradesh, Jammu &*

*Kashmir, Ladakh, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Sikkim and West Bengal are under process to establish).*

- iv. Regulatory Authorities of 30 States/UTs have operationalized their websites under the provisions of RERA. *(Arunachal Pradesh and Manipur are under process to operationalize).*
- v. 1,07,311 Real Estate Projects and 76,985 Real Estate Agents have registered under RERA across the country.
- vi. 1,10,817 Complaints have been disposed-off by the Real Estate Regulatory Authorities across the country. 4326 projects and 4323 agents have been registered during the month March 2023.
