## Monthly summary on the principal activities of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the month of January, 2020

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### I. Swachh Bharat Mission

- i. 1.70 crore citizens are registered on the Swachhata App, 1.91 crore complaints have been registered out of which more than 93 % complaints have been resolved.
- ii. On Swachh Bharat Helpline (1969), for all issues related to Swachh Bharat, 5.25 lakh calls have been answered with an average handling time of 1 minute 28 seconds.
- iii. A total of 4,324 cities/ towns has been declared as ODF (Open Defecation Free), 1,301 cities have been certified as ODF+ and 427 cities have been certified as ODF++. An ODF++ city requires to achieve sanitation sustainability by addressing complete sanitation, including safe containment, processing and disposal of faecal sludge and septage.
- iv. 58,798 toilet across 2,642 cities are live on Google Maps with the name of "SBM Toilet" covering 55% of urban population.
- v. 266 cities have been registered on Swachh Nagar Mobile App so far. This app helps in effective waste management of a city like monitoring, collection of segregate waste, tracking the movement of waste vehicles etc.
- vi. As on date 9,600 Garbage Vulnerable Points (GVP) have been mapped, out of which 1,229 are being monitored. 390 cities comprising of 2,345 active wards are using this module. The Swachh Survekshan 2020 has a dedicated indicator on monitoring and transformation of GVPs.
- vii. The number of cities with 5 Star Certification is 4, 3 Star Certification is 56 and 1 Star Certification is 4 under Star Rating Protocol for Garbage Free Cities.
- viii. Under Swachh Manch, 3,512 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) are involved by posting of 1,52,490 events with more than 7.16 crore citizen's participation.
- ix. The MIS system developed for Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) has received "**Award for Excellence**" by the Computer Science Society of India (CSI) during their annual **CSI SIG e-Governance Awards** at Hyderabad for the period of 2019-2020. A total of 58 Government projects competed for this award.
- x. A series of Exposure Workshops have been organised to spread awareness about issues and challenges of Solid Waste



Management (SWM), Faecal Sludge and Septage Management (FSSM), Wastewater and sustainable sanitation. By the end of January, 2020, 616 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) have participated with more than 1,167 participants in the 34 workshops over 250 ULBs.

## **II. Smart Cities Mission**

- i. In the month of January 2020, 92 projects worth Rs. 1,210 crore have achieved completion, work started on 85 projects worth Rs. 10,580 crore and tenders have been issued for 92 projects worth Rs. 2,583 crore. As on 31st January 2020, total 4,488 projects worth Rs. 1,62,795 crore have been tendered, work orders have been issued for 3,649 projects worth Rs. 1,20,060 crore and 1,553 projects worth Rs. 25,677 crore have been completed.
- ii. Third APEX conference of Smart Cities was held on 24<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 in Vizag Smart City with participation of Principal Secretaries of State Urban Development Departments, Mayors/Municipal Commissioners/ CEOs of Smart Cities, representatives of Bilateral/Multilateral Institutions and other key stakeholders. During the Conference, India Smart Cities Awards were distributed to winning Smart Cities.

## **III. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)**

- i. State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) have been approved for all the States for Rs. 77,640 crore. Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) have been approved for the projects costing Rs. 83,743 crore. Out of the total SAAPs, work has been completed for 2,430 projects worth Rs. 8,671 crore, contracts have been awarded for 2,920 projects worth Rs. 64,522 crore, 322 projects worth Rs. 6,738 crore are under tendering and Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) worth Rs. 4,457 crore under preparation.
- ii. So far, Rs. 24,388.32 crore has been released to States/UTs towards project implementation, Administrative & Office Expenses, Reform Incentive and for formulation of GIS based Master Plans & Local Area Plan (LAP) and Town Planning Schemes (TPS).

## **IV. Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana / National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY/NULM)**

- i. A total of Rs. 28.93 crore has been released during the month.
- ii. 11,428 Self Help Groups (SHGs) were formed, 14,982 SHGs were given Revolving Fund, 16,936 candidates were skill trained and



certified, 4,612 trained candidates were given placement, 10,478 beneficiaries were assisted with loans for setting up of individual and micro enterprises, and 65,022 loans were given to SHGs under SHG-Bank linkage programme.

## **V. Pradan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)/ Housing for All (HFA)**

- i. A total of Rs. 80.96 crore has been released during the month.
- ii. Since the inception of the Mission, it has achieved milestone of sanctioning more than 1.03 crore houses against the validated demand of 1.12 crore houses. 60.51 lakh houses have been grounded for construction of which 32.07 lakh houses have been completed.
- iii. The four-month campaign namely 'ANGIKAAR' formally launched on 2nd October, 2019 in more than 4000 cities, for change management for PMAY (U) beneficiaries has formally culminated in all cities on January 26th, 2020.

## **VI. Housing**

- i. 30 States/ UTs have notified rules under RERA; 4 North Eastern States namely Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland and Sikkim are under process to notify the rules under RERA.
- ii. 31 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Regulatory Authority (Regular - 25, Interim - 06).
- iii. 25 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Appellate Tribunal (Regular -17, Interim - 08).
- iv. Regulatory Authorities of 26 States/UTs have operationalised their websites under the provisions of RERA.
- v. So far, 41,889 complaints have been disposed off by the Real Estate Regulatory Authorities including 6993 complaints during January, 2020 across the country.
- vi. 1311 projects and 1021 agents have been registered in month of January, 2020 across the country. So far, 49,492 projects and 38,886 agents have been registered under RERA.

## **VII. NBCC**

- i. Nigerian President, H. E. Mahamadou Issoufou & External Affairs' Minister, Dr. S. Jaishankar jointly inaugurated Mahatma Gandhi International Convention Centre (MGICC) in Niamey, Niger. The landmark project completed by NBCC on behalf of MyGov India, promotes Indo-Niger friendship.
- ii. NBCC (India) Ltd. and its subsidiary NBCC Service Limited signed an MoU with National Dairy Development Board (NDDB) Foundation for Nutrition to contribute Rs. 50 Lakh and Rs. 22.17 Lakh respectively.
