Monthly summary on the principal activities of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the month of September, 2019

I. Swachh Bharat Mission

- i. 1.56 crore citizens are registered on the Swachhata App, 1.77 crore complaints have been registered out of which 93 % complaints have been resolved.
- ii. Rs. 597.45 crore has been released to the States during the month.
- iii. On Swachh Bharat Helpline (1969), for all issues related to Swachh Bharat, 4.99 Lakh calls have been answered with an average handling time of 1 minute 29 seconds.
- iv. 'Swachh Manch' is the citizen engagement platform under Swachh Bharat Mission where citizens can contribute more actively by volunteering towards cleaner neighbourhoods with support of their Municipal Corporations to next level. In this 1.75 lakh events are posted, 6.41 crore people participated and 3,252 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) are on board. About 4,024 Metric Tonne of plastic waste collected and about 1,400 Metric Tonne has been sent to Cement Manufacturer's Association (CMA) for processing.
- v. 57,000 toilet across 2,300 cities are live on Google Maps with the name of "SBM Toilet".
- vi. Swachh Nagar Mobile App was launched with features such as tracking of waste collection through route and vehicle monitoring, notification to citizens etc. to ensure effective waste management for ULBs. 40 cities have been registered on Swachh Nagar Mobile App so far.
- vii. A module has been developed to monitor Garbage Vulnerable Points on the existing Google Toilet Locator (GTL) mobile application for the ease of ULBs. As on date 7,938 GVPs have been mapped, out of which 579 are being monitored. 313 cities comprising of 1,917 active wards are using this module. The Swachh Survekshan 2020 has a dedicated indicator on monitoring and transformation of GVPs.
- viii. United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) is implementing the project Sustainable Cities Integrated Approach Pilot in India ("SC-IAP in India") in coordination with Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs with the funding assistance from the Global Environment Facility (GEF). The project is under implementation in 5 selected cities by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Bhopal Municipal Corporation, Mysore Municipal Corporation, Vijayawada Municipal Corporation, Guntur Municipal Corporation and Jaipur Municipal Corporation.
- ix. State level workshops are being organized to keep Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) updated on the Swachh Survekshan (including SS League) methodology, components and various indicators and address queries related to the same in various ULBs by the Ministry. A total of 24 capacity building workshops have been conducted in the States/UTs in September 2019 with participation of over 8,400 ULBs and State level officials. National Safai

Karamchari Finance and Development Corporation (NSKFDC) is also providing inputs for elimination of hazardous cleaning and QCI is on how to ensure hundred percent treatment of faecal sludge before being discharged in environment.

x. For implementation of 'Swachhata Hi Seva' launched on September 11, 2019 by Hon'ble Prime Minister, an intensive campaign has been launched to activate all States and cities to bring to reality the vision of a single use plastic (SUP) free India. The campaign has been divided into three phases, namely: (i) 11th September – 1st October: Preparation & Awareness; (ii) 2nd October: Shramdaan and (iii) 3rd October – 27th October: Recycle/disposal. Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has requested all the States/UTs that they should organize large scale citizen engagement activities for awareness generation and community mobilization through Sharamdaan, Clean & Green Drives, Swachhata Pledges, Swachhata Rallies, etc, aimed at mass scale plastic waste collection and disposal.

II. Smart Cities Mission

- i. Work has been completed in 19 projects worth Rs. 98.17 crore, work was started for 49 projects worth Rs. 566.51 crore and tendering was started in 126 projects worth Rs. 1,931.34 crore. With this, 1,229 projects worth Rs. 21,725 crore have been completed, 1,993 projects worth Rs. 80,222 crore are currently under implementation and 791 projects worth Rs. 42,654 crore are under tendering.
- ii. On the occasion of the 4th Anniversary of Smart Cities Mission, a 100 Days Program titled "ONE-CITY, ONE-IMPACT" was launched in collaboration with all the 100 Smart Cities. The Mission will achieve 100 impacts across 100 Smart Cities. These initiatives focused on five themes: Inclusion, Environment, Cleanliness, Economy and Water including plantation of more than 1 lakh trees, restoration/redevelopment of more than 100 public spaces. Nearly 2.7 crore citizens will be directly benefited from this programme.
- iii. 100 Smart Cities have been registered on the Public Financial Management System (PFMS) which will enable effective tracking of fund flow for the implementation of Smart Cities.
- iv. In connection with Commemoration of 550th Birth Anniversary of Shri Guru Nanak Dev Ji, the proposal of Government of Punjab to develop Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, Punjab on lines of Smart Cities principles at an estimated cost of Rs. 271.11 crore has been approved by Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs for release of Rs. 135.55 crore i.e. 50% of the project cost. The first installment of Rs. 27.11 crore has been released to the Government of Punjab.

III. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

- i. State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) to the tune of Rs. 77,640 crore have been finalized for all the States. Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) for

projects costing Rs. 80,463 crore have been approved. 1,980 projects worth Rs. 5,936 crore have been completed, contracts have been awarded for 3,214 projects worth Rs. 63,549 crore and 270 projects worth Rs. 6,269 crore are under tendering and DPRs worth Rs. 6,387 crore are under preparation.

ii. So far, Rs. 22,623 crore has been released to States/UTs towards project implementation, Administrative & Office Expenses, Reform Incentive and for formulation of GIS based Master Plans.

IV. Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana / National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY/NULM)

i. A total of Rs. 98.86 crore has been released during the month.

ii. 10,150 Self Help Groups (SHGs) were formed, 4,148 SHGs were given Revolving Fund, 11,147 candidates were skill trained and certified, 3,155 trained candidates were given placement, 6,656 beneficiaries were assisted with loans for setting up of individual and micro enterprises, and 9,730 loans were given to SHGs under SHG-Bank linkage programme.

V. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)/ Housing for All (HFA)

i. A total of Rs. 5573.87 crore has been released during the month.

ii. More than 90 lakh dwelling units in 19,100 projects with an investment of Rs. 5,54,379 crore involving Central assistance of Rs. 1,42,528 crore have been approved under PMAY. So far, 53,39,991 houses have been grounded for construction, 27,16,649 houses have already been constructed and 24,74,920 houses have been occupied.

iii. A one-day National Workshop namely "Master Trainers Workshop on Angikaar" held on 5th September, 2019 at India Habitat Centre, Delhi wherein States/UTs were oriented about the concept of the Angikaar campaign & activities to be undertaken alongwith timelines for rollout of angikaar campaign under PMAY(U).

VI. Housing

i. 30 States/ UTs have notified rules under RERA; 4 North Eastern States namely Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland and Sikkim are under process to notify the rules under RERA.

ii. 29 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Regulatory Authority (Regular - 21, Interim - 08) (Lakshadweep is under process).

iii. 23 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Appellate Tribunal (Regular -14, Interim - 09).

iv. Regulatory Authorities of 24 States/UTs have operationalised their websites under the provisions of RERA.

v. 1021 projects and 733 agents have been registered in month of September, 2019 across the country.

VII. NBCC

- i. NBCC signed MoU with UTKAL University, Bhubaneswar, Odisha for construction of its various buildings at an approx cost of Rs. 390 crore.
- ii. Agreement was signed between NBCC and Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Sambalpur, Odisha for construction of new Permanent Campus at a cost of Rs. 400 crore.
