

## PART VIII

### POWERS, PROCEDURES, OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

#### **XXVI. Procedure, Rules and Regulations, Offences and Penalties and Supplemental Provisions**

28. *This Part in any municipal law features the time-tested procedural matters. As such, no new policy issues are involved except that the State Legislatures may specify that certain offences shall be cognizable and non-bailable within the meaning of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, as in the case of sub-clause (2) of clause 408 on Construction of building in contravention of the provisions of the Act or the rules made thereunder.*

- P. General Provisions.
