Monthly summary on the principal activities of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the month of March, 2022

I. Swachh Bharat Mission

- i. 4,371 cities/ towns have been declared as ODF (Open Defecation Free) of which 4,316 cities have been certified through third party verification, 3,350 cities have been certified as ODF+, 963 cities have been certified as ODF++ and 9 cities have been certified as Water+.
- ii. 67,407 toilets across more than 3,326 cities are live on Google Maps with the name of "SBM Toilet".
- iii. Swachhata App emerged as an important tool towards enabling citizens to have their grievances addressed by the concerned Municipal Corporation. The revised version enables citizens to get their COVID-related complaints also redressed by their respective ULBs. The Swachhata App has a total of 1.93 crore users, who have posted 2.52 crore complaints, of which 2.35 crore complaints have been resolved, with a resolution of above 93.25%.
- iv. On 3rd March, 2022, National Conclave on 'Social Enterprise for Garbage Free Cities: Encouraging Women Entrepreneurs in Waste Management' was organized at Raipur in collaboration with Government of Chhatisgarh. Key highlight of day was a series of presentations from women-led waste management enterprises. These included Hasiru Dala, a Bangalore-based organization working with waste pickers, Pune's Red Dot campaign by SWaCH co-operative working to spread awareness regarding menstrual health, Gurugram's SAAHAS NGO working on source segregation of waste, SHE teams from Tiruchirappalli, Tamil Nadu engaged in operating and maintaining community toilets in slums, and transgender teams from Cuttack operating and managing end to end sanitation facilities — from community toilets to faecal sludge treatment plants.
- v. On 25th March 2022, SBM-Urban organized the first-of-its-kind "SwachhTalks" as part of its peer-learning webinar series for States/UTs and ULBs, with the theme "SafaiMitra Suraksha in 100 lighthouse cities". The objective of the webinar was to accelerate the progress of these 100 cities towards complete 'manhole to machinehole' transformation to ensure safety and security of SafaiMitras. The top 6 cities in the Challenge: Indore and Navi Mumbai in population category of >10 lakhs, Nellore and Jamshedpur in population category of 3-10 lakhs, and Dewas and Karimnagar in population category of <3 lakhs, presented their good practices in SafaiMitra Suraksha.

II. Smart Cities Mission (SCM)

- i. During the month 230 projects worth ₹ 2,461 crore have been completed and work has been started on 1212 projects worth ₹ 19,017 crore. So far 7,901 projects worth ₹1,92,224 crore have been tendered, work orders have been

- ii. A total of ₹5784.36 crore have been released during the month.

VI. Housing.

- i. All States/ UTs have notified rules under RERA except Nagaland, which is under process to notify the rules.
- ii. 31 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Regulatory Authority (Regular - 25, Interim - 06). Ladakh, Meghalaya, Sikkim & West Bengal have notified the rules while yet to establish authority.
- iii. 28 States/UTs have set up Real Estate Appellate Tribunal (Regular -24, Interim – 04).
- iv. Regulatory Authorities of 28 States/UTs have operationalized their websites under the provisions of RERA.
- v. So far, 87,633 complaints (including 2,061 complaints during the month) have been disposed of by the Real Estate Regulatory Authorities across the country
- vi. So far, 78,225 projects and 61,551 agents have been registered under RERA. 2,506 projects and 1,520 agents have been registered during the month.

issued for 7,692 projects worth ₹ 1,80,534 crore out of which 3,844 projects worth ₹ 61,607 crore have been completed.

- ii. SCM hosted a virtual Deep Dive workshop on National Urban Digital Mission (NUDM) Draft Knowledge Standards for Municipal Governance released by NIUA.
- iii. On 16 March 2022, names of 11 winning cities of the EatSmart Cities Challenge were announced in an online event in the presence of Secretary (HUA).

III. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

- i. State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) have been finalized for all the states for ₹77,640 crore. As on date, Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) have been approved for the projects costing ₹82,247 crore. Some States have taken up projects in excess of their approved SAAPs. Entire excess amount in such cases will be borne by the States/ULBs. Works have been completed for 4,199 projects worth ₹26,432 crore and work is in progress for 1,651 projects worth ₹54,922 crore. In all, physical work worth about ₹61,225 crore has been carried out in completed/ongoing AMRUT projects implying that around 79% of physical work has been completed.
- ii. So far, ₹37,491 crore has been released to States/UTs towards project implementation (including the eligible projects of erstwhile JnNURM), Administrative & Office Expenses (A&OE), reform incentive, and under sub-schemes on 'Formulation of GIS based Master Plans in AMRUT cities' and 'Local Area Plan (LAP) and Town Planning Schemes (TPS)' in 25 selected cities.

IV. Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana /National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY/NULM)

- i. 13,022 Self Help Groups (SHGs) have been formed; 9,629 SHGs were given Revolving Fund; 7,573 candidates were skill trained and certified; 2,595 trained candidates were given placement; 19,095 beneficiaries were assisted with loans for setting up of individual and micro enterprises and 30,084 loans were given to SHGs under SHG-Bank linkage programme.
- ii. Under PM Street Vendor's AtmaNirbhar Nidhi (PMSVANidhi), 45,25,745 applications have been received against which 33,73,581 sanctions and 30,89,093 disbursements have been made.
- iii. A total of ₹198.19 crore under DAY-NULM scheme and ₹141.50 crore under PMSVANidhi scheme have been released during the month.

V. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)/Housing for All (HFA)

- i. Since the inception, Mission has sanctioned 1.23 crore houses of which 97.02 lakh houses have been grounded for construction of which 58.01 lakh houses have been completed/delivered.
