G.S.R. _____(E) .— In exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Central Public Works Department, Director General, (Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules, 2020, namely: -

1. (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Central Public Works Department, Director General, (Group 'A' post) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Central Public Works Department, Director General, (Group 'A' post), Recruitment Rules, 2020, for the Schedule, the following Schedule shall be substituted, namely: -

(3) A Selection Committee comprising of CEO, Niti Aayog; Secretary, DOP&T; Secretary MoHUA, Secretary, MoRTH; and an eminent outside expert in the field to be appointed by the Ministry (MoHUA) with the approval of the Minister, MoHUA to make the overall assessment of officers, based on the following inputs:

a. Assessment of APARs of the Candidates for the last 5 years

b. Multi source Feed back

c. Application of officers detailing their experience & achievements including their vision and strategy to achieve objectives of the organization.

d. Personal interview, if required

(4) A panel will be drawn up accordingly in the order of merit by the Selection Committee. The recommendations of the Selection Committee will then be submitted for consideration/approval of the ACC for selection of the officer to the post of DG,

to be appointed with the approval of Minister, MoHUA.]

(5) The initial tenure of deputation shall be 02 years, extendable on a case-to-case basis.
